Minutes of AGM Thursday 18 September 2014:

Copies available and Members had been sent copies by email prior to the meeting.

Matters arising:

AW mentioned that the question of starting time had been raised by some players at matches this year if matches not started by 6.15 pm. The generally accepted start time is 6.15 but acknowledging that in the case of players who worked 6.30 might be preferred. Agreed to stick with the adhoc arrangement of 6.15 if at all possible and in any event no later than 6.30 and if all players present then start as soon as possible. Aw asked MD if there was a problem at Vivary because of the parking but was advised that there was no problem and most matches started at 6.15.

In trying to piece together past winners DB had provide AW details of past winners in Div2 and we now had a record from 1995 of winners and runners up in Div 2 and from 1995 runners up in Div 1, It was pointed out at last years AGM that Div 1 Runners up Shield an Div 2 shields were only inscribed from 2002, therefore there were shields missing the obvious enquiry being the clubs who won them in 2001. Vivary and Donyatt. Aw had enquired of both clubs but drawn a blank.

The Div 2 trophy shield had been refurbished as suggested at the last meeting and Roland had offered to bear the cost. This had been done at a cost of £48 and we are most grateful to Roland for his generosity.

Secretary's report AGM 2015

Our Chairman in his report last year commented how nice the weather had been and hoped for the same this year. Well I hope he hopes for the same tonight and pulls it off again next season.

All 90 league matches were played in glorious evening sunshine in nigh perfect bowling conditions on excellent greens with enjoyable company. For a men's night out it couldn't be bettered.

In the WSL all games are keenly contested in a friendly sporting manner and there were a number of extremely close matches. I have picked out a few worthy of mention.

By week 4 there were no unbeaten teams in Division 1 and only Bridgwater B were unbeaten in Division 2 a situation that remained throughout; an outstanding performance.

Wellington A were still without a win by week 6 and since they were playing league leaders Minehead A they seemed likely remain so, but came away with 10 points – that's bowls.

Quite a number of matches went to the wire . TD A v NP A where the last wood on the last end determined the overall winner .

There were 4 matches won/lost by 1 shot; 4 by 2 shots and 4 by 3 shots; no doubt those of you who participated in those matches remember them well.

One match which stands out as perhaps the most exciting was Watchet v Victoria where the home side leading by 14 shots on the last end were home and dry but dropped a 2, a 3 and a 6 to scrape through by 1 shot on each rink. Nail biting stuff.

The leader board in Div 1 was not unlike musical chairs played out by Williton, Minehead A and Bridgwater A who interchanged each week. Going into the last match on week 9 they all had 68 points each with the championship within the grasp of all 3.

The outcome was that Williton won 12 nil to become Div 1 Champions and Bridgwater A with a 10-2 win are runners up for the second year. Minehead lost and ended up 3rd.

Well done too to Bridgwater B for a brilliant unbeaten performance and only losing on 4 rinks and ending with 100 points.

Watchet must be well pleased and rightly so in gaining promotion in their second season.

That said it was a close run thing as they only had a 4 points lead over Taunton Deane B going into the last match.

However Victoria put paid to any hopes TD B had by beating them 10 points to 2 while Watchet managed an 8-4 win at Vivary.

Newcomers Taunton Vivary C had a baptism of fire losing all their matches . I was concerned, unnecessarily as it turns out, that they may not enter next season. They can take heart that they scored more shots than each of the 4 teams above them.

High scores statistics Bridgwater B 82 v Burnham B 25 and 84 – 31 v Taunton Vivary B . However these were bettered by Williton who Wellington B 87-26. Interestingly there were 11 matches with scores of 8 points to 4 emphasising the importance of rink points and big margins for winning rinks .
