Discussion	<p>An order was now in place for 2 items of playground equipment to cater for different age groups. Expected installation date was 15<sup>th</sup> May. Total net cost once VAT was reclaimed would be £9330. NVE had pledged £1000 towards the cost and Beechgrove were organising a fund raising concert. Cllr Manion offered some finance and would send the Clerk a form to fill in.</p> <p>.</p>

TRAFFIC GROUP		Cllr Tee	
Discussion	<p>Volunteers were needed to get Speedwatch training. Cllr Norton said that an online course was available for new volunteers and provided forms for distribution.</p> <p>Traffic surveys should be delivered within the next week. Residents were asked to return them via the village hall letterbox.</p> <p>Cllr Tee had attended a meeting regarding the Aylesham development and said that there were going to be another 200 homes built in excess of the 1200 proposed. No Traffic increase was apparent from the camera data as the development progressed.</p> <p>The MLM traffic surveys the developers use have also shown no significant increase in traffic.</p> <p>Also, there is no money available from section 106 for our traffic calming. However, if the MLM surveys show a significant increase after the next phase it would have to be addressed by the building consortium</p> <p>The PC had received a request from Wingham PC to support their traffic group and the increased traffic along Addisham Rd. It was decided to send a message of support but, because Nonington had its own issues with speeding and would be working on that this year, then we could not help Wingham PC further than that.</p> <p>There is now a dedicated website for traffic issues through Nonington: <a href="http://nonington.traffic.nabob.co.uk/">http://nonington.traffic.nabob.co.uk/</a></p>

Discussion	<p>The tree tunnel' road along Vicarage Lane was still too narrow due to slippage from the banks.</p> <p>Cllr Perrin will be updating the new residents packs.</p> <p>Cllr Perrin said that the notices at Beechgrove directing walkers away from some perceived footpaths were correctly posted. All official footpaths were open.</p> <p>Dog fouling had increased along Vicarage Lane and Park View Rise. Notices would be put on nearby infrastructure warning of possible fines for dog fouling.
