The annual safety inspection had been completed by RoSPA Playsafety Ltd and was the best report we have had. There was some remedial work required.  The goal posts were rusted and in danger of collapse. Cllr Tee said he had contacted Beechgrove who may be able to weld some repairs.  Air Skier adult equipment was swinging to high. Cllr Parker was seeking a fix for this.  The basketball rings signage against climbing or hanging from the ring was required.  The barbed wire on the south fence was raised in the report but it was felt there was little that could be done as it was adjacent to a field that had animals loose.  Cllr Parker suggested a pond clean up day and would organise one in the autumn, probably October.
