1. SSE have yet to send a correct final bill for our three electricity supplies which were changed to Octopus. This is being chased.	NO	Work in Progress.
2. Correspondence received from two local landowners in relation to footpaths.	NO	Publicise in Magazine, Nextdoor and Facebook.
"We already have a well-used Footpath from the playing fields over to my old grainstore at Berrycourt, and have no wish to create another one by default through unopposed usage.  I erected two signs saying NO RIGHT OF WAY, which were knocked down within a week.  If this unauthorised access continues, I shall have to consider the work put into hedgecutting the track running From Peacocks cottages down to the splash and Heathman street which keeps the permitted access open, that I granted to riders and walkers, at a Parish Council meeting some years ago."		
Another landowner confirmed that the problem is becoming a serious issue.		
" I would make a polite request that everyone keeps to the official footpaths when walking in the countryside. Over the last year it has been noticed that significantly more people (and their dogs) are straying into private land without permission."		
Clerk's note: Some of the footpaths are "permissive" which means that they can be revoked should the owner wish to do so. Nobody would like that to happen, so please be mindful of keeping to all the designated footpaths and please keep dogs on leads or under close control at all times.
