Planning Appication : Mrs Clemitson and Mrs Van Cleef attended the meeting to explain their plans that are	
to be submitted to the Borough Council in early March. Their proposal is to build 2 homes behind their current homes with a shared driveway to enable them to remain in the village but to not have such large	
gardens to maintain. Ashford Borough Council has viewed the preliminary plans and has agreed in principle.	
The Parish Councillors needed time to consider what impact this might have although it is noted that the	
applicants have tried to minimise the impact on the immediate neighbours.	
Petworth: Immediate neighbours and active complainants have now received a letter from Ashford Borough	
Council outlining that the Borough Council Enforcement Order has been appealed against with the following	
as reasons:	
That there has not been a breach of planning control.	
That, at the time of the enforcement notice was issued, it was too late to take enforcement	
action against the matters stated in the notice.	
The steps required to comply with the requirements of the notice are excessive, and lesser	
steps would overcome the objections.	
That the time given to comply with the notice is too short.	
The appellant has requested that this appeal be dealt by way of a Public Inquiry .	

It was felt that the matter being dealt with as a public inquiry was not in the interests of the public.

Report from Borough Councillor	
S. 106 at Stour Park	
The details of this are not yet finalised but the Parish Council will not benefit from this. It is hoped it will pay	
for the closure of Kingsford Street and a turning circle	
Finberry	
The building at Finberry has now reached 230 houses, there are a number of trigger points that are to be hit	
in the on-coming months, at 301 houses the agreement requires the bridge road to be put in, at 400 houses,	
the community centre becomes required. At 500 houses a full set of working traffic lights will need to be in	
operation. The Parish Council will again be involved quite soon.	
Waterbrook	
A planning application is imminent to relocate and expand the lorry park so that it is nearer the VOSA site.	
There are issues that have been highlighted by the Environment Agency with regard to flooding. The new	
lorry park is looking to hold 600 lorries whereas the current lorry park holds 375 lorries.	
Damian Green suggested that legislation will probably be passed once sufficient parks are provided to ensure	
that lorries are parked in lorry parks and not on sides of roads.	
Potentially, though, there might be a plan to put housing at Waterbrook and there will be a problem for the	
residents in that housing with noise and over-flow parking etc.	
Affordable Housing	
Once the Affordable Housing project at Bower Road is built and occupied it is possible that additional housing	
will be provided replicating this project, maybe in Kingsnorth or near by. Funding may not be available but it	
is something that might be looked at in the future.

Meetings accessible to some of the Sevington North residents. This was suggested as not practical at this time as there is no way of telling residents about the change of location.
