Thomas Taylor Blaze, A versatile mid range indoor bowl which has a noticeable stronger finish.

Aero Quantum.

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. Plays as wide as the ace but has a constant bias.

Almark Sterling Slim-line,
A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. Made from a slightly heavier compound so roughly a few grams heavier.

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front end bowlers outdoors. The shoulder is slightly forward creating a stronger finish, commonly known as it's hockey stick finish.

Henselite Tiger Pro.

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front-mid end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors.

Drakes Pride Professional,
A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front - mid end bowlers
outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a more subtle finish outdoors. One of the most
popular bowls in the UK.

A mid line bowl, generally aimed at back end bowlers indoors and front - mid end bowlers outdoors. Has a strong finish indoors and a slightly stronger finish outdoors than the group above playing slightly wider than the Drake Pride Professional. One of the most popular bowls in the UK.

Henselite Tiger Evo,

Aimed at back end bowlers on slower running indoor greens, generally more suited to back end bowlers outdoors. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Drakes Pride XP, Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Thomas Taylor International, Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Airned at back end outdoor bowlers. Has a stronger finish/hook than the mid-line bowls.

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. Has a constant bias.

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers and is the slimline Outdoor Model from Taylors.

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. Has a constant bias.

Thomas Taylor Lignoid,

Aimed at back end outdoor bowlers and is one of the widest swinging bowls available with a strong hook finish.

Henselste Classic, Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. The famous 'hockey stick bias' is an excellent wide drawing bowl for all outdoor surfaces.

Aimed at back end outdoors bowlers. Has a constant bias.
