Councillors should be aware that if a 3rd party insurance fails to cover an incident, it is likely that a claimant may then seek to claim on the council's insurance.

1. Councillors to decide if permission can be given for BBQs at the above specified events.

2. <u>Councillors to decide if the below conditions are appropriate for permitted BBQ use at public events:</u>

- Risk Assessments,
- Sited where it cannot be walked into
- Sand/Water firefighting equipment in place
- Food to be kept chilled until it is cooked.
- Hand washing facilities to be available.

- Persons taking payment not to handle food. •
- Sign stating where profits from stall will go.
- Prices not to be set so high as to prevent households with lower incomes from purchasing.
