After discussion it was proposed to purchase 6 benches and 10 planters for the refurbishment of the Seawall Garden area- A total of £6381.60 including VAT.

It was further agreed that the option to offer these benches and planters to be dedicated to a family or business in the Parish. It was agreed that this opportunity would fall outside of the bench policy as this was a specific project to enhance the village environment. Details of the cost for the dedication would be managed by the Parish Clerk to cover bench and planter costs, a plaque and installation.
