SO, WHAT IS HAPPENING AT MANSTON AIRPORT?

The first thing to state is that the Government has now designated the airport as Nationally Important Infrastructure, whether it is used solely for freight or not, and it will therefore always remain as an airport, and it cannot be used for any other purpose. The DCO (Development Consent Order) was granted by the Secretary of State (SoS) on the 30th of July to the new owners, Riveroak, to construct a Cargo base over the next few years starting next year. Work on this £300m development will begin in 2021.

Currently, as you may know, the airport has been rented by the Department for Transport (DfT) as a Brexit lorry parking area with capacity for 6000 or more vehicles. This was supposed to last until the end of the year and is why Riveroak have not been able to start their development. It now seems that the delay will continue for a while after the end of year because the DfT wants to continue to keep it as a lorry park "just in case" no deal can be struck with the EU by the end of this month.

Many new innovations are planned to be incorporated in the new Manston. The developers have stated their intention to make it a totally 'carbon free' project by using clean fuels wherever possible and keeping abreast of the ever-improving development of electric flight, a subject being taken very seriously by all of the major aircraft and aero-engine manufacturers. It will be a while before such advances become commonplace but Manston will be ready for them when they arrive, whereas existing airports will not. Added to this an engineering training academy is planned for the site.

Regardless of what the 'nay-sayers' think, Thanet stands to really benefit from this!!

However, there is a small minority of objectors to the project (based mainly in Ramsgate) who are trying to get the DCO decision blocked by pushing for a Judicial Review. However, comments by people who have more knowledge of these matters than I, have said it is almost unknown for a Secretary of State decision to be over-turned.

A lot of false speculation has been circulated by the 'anti' group about the terrible things that will blight the lives of Thanet residents if the operation goes ahead. These include fake flight plans above the Isle, fake stacking areas, grossly exaggerated numbers of flights, terrifying sound levels and the threat of the annihilation of birds and wildlife within an area of 13 kilometres radius of the airport. Please ignore these stories, which have no basis in reality!
