## 129/1920 SCHEME OF DELEGATION, AMENDMENT TO FINANCIAL REGULTION AND EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, it was necessary to set up emergency arrangements in the event of the council being unable to meet.

It was **RESOLVED** to agree the following arrangements, which would stay in place for as long as necessary.

- It is lawful for the clerk to spend against items agreed in the Parish Council's 2020-21 budget. In making such payments, in unforeseen circumstances, (e.g. insurance premium higher than anticipated), the budget may be exceeded by up to 15%.
- Financial Regulations to be amended so that there are delegated powers for the Clerk/Locum Clerk to spend up to £2,000 per transaction (increased from £1,000), to authorise urgent work when unforeseen circumstances occur. Examples of such work are urgent repairs to parish assets like the play equipment
- Clerk to have delegated power to transfer funds within the council's bank accounts, to ensure that no more than £85k is held in each account thereby ensuring FSCS protection is maximised.
- Clerk to have delegated power to respond to planning applications (councillors are still able to submit their own personal comments)
- Council meeting on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2020 to be cancelled & further meetings should this be required
- Clerk to have delegated authority to receive and act upon Government advice in relation to the holding of the Annual Meeting of the Parish, scheduled to meet on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2020, (noting such meetings must be held before 1 June) and the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council scheduled to meet on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2020, thereby giving delegated power to the Clerk (or Locum Clerk) to make necessary re-arrangements for these meetings in consultation with the Chair.

130/1920 **COUNCIL'S BANKING** – it was **RESOLVED** that once the Nationwide account is set up, the funds be split so no deposit in excess of £85,000 is held with any one bank
