COUNTY AND PRESIDENTS MATCHES

Westsports Trophy

Devon won the first leg at Bodmin by 15 shots and the second leg at Torbay by 7 shots thus retaining this very competitive trophy. Much to the chagrin of Cornwall this is the ninth year running that Devon have won the trophy. In fact, since the new trophy was presented Devon is the only name on it!

The initial Inter County Shield was played for between Devon and Cornwall. This Shield is contested by gaining 2 points for a rink win and 1 point for the losing rink. The score in total over the two legs gave a victory for Devon by two points, so winning the inaugural Shield.

Total Inter County matches played was: Five matches played winning one and losing four.

Presidents matches played was a total of seventeen, winning five and losing ten, with two matches unfortunately cancelled.

MEMBERSHIP

After increasing our membership in the last season before covid struck, the Association suffered a significant loss of members at the the start of the 21/22 season. This loss amounted to a loss of thirty per cent of our total membership. Taken together with the financial loss to our revenues, we certainly have a large task in front of us to bring it back up to previous levels.
