- Residents asked how the Environmental Weight limit would be monitored. BL confirmed that the final consultation is almost complete and the signs should go up at the end of the month. There is a monitoring system for if the weight limit is broken. KS reported that the PCSO is happy to take information regarding offenders and warn them that they are breaking the law. When the next newsletter is produced instructions should be included on how to monitor and report offenders. There is a Lorry Watch scheme which KS is willing to co-ordinate to monitor the situation.
- It was noted that there have been some more measurements of doorstep levels at various properties by the Environment Agency regarding flood levels but there are no results as yet.
