

Community Urged to Report Bad Behaviour

Representatives from Newark and Sherwood District Council Public Protection, Nottinghamshire Police and Fernwood Parish Council have met to discuss what is being done to tackle the escalating issues of antisocial behaviour.

The number of calls to the Police is relatively low. We urge you to Report It:

For a crime in progress or emergency, ring 999. To report a crime or nuisance, call the Police on 101.

The following actions are being taken to deal with this problem:

- Individuals identified as being involved with recent problems are being visited by the Police/ Antisocial Behaviour Officer. If the people involved continue to offend the enforcement action will be escalated.
- 2. Patrols by the Community Protection Officer and Police are being increased.
- 3. The Schools Officer is going into local schools to talk about these issues and the possible consequences.
- 4. CCTV is being put up to monitor the bus shelter that has been vandalised. There is also CCTV around the village hall.
- 5. A Police Architectural Technician will be visiting the area to advise on what can be done to deter the type of behaviour that has been experienced.
- 6. Work is being done with the Youth Service, Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator, Newark and Sherwood District Council, Nottinghamshire County Council and Fernwood Parish Council to help tackle this issue. This includes looking at what can be done to engage with and provide activities for young people.

We cannot promise to resolve the problem immediately but wanted to assure you this problem is being taken seriously.

Please remember to Report It. The idea of the campaign is to advertise the appropriate route to address problems such as noise, rowdy behaviour and other such nuisance.

Terry Bailey, Antisocial Behaviour Officer said 'We feel it is important that residents feel safe and secure in their homes and communities. Residents should feel confident that when they report matters to the appropriate agencies that something can and will be done. The more information provided by residents such as times and dates and descriptions the more chance that agencies have at placing the appropriate resources in place to help solve the problem'.

Fernwood Parish Chairman, Barry Smith, said 'Fernwood Parish Council encourages residents to call the Police when they come across antisocial behaviour. There are often discussions on social media but this is not reflected in the figures the Police and the District Council Public Protection Team have for Fernwood. To tackle these issues, we need to inform the Police or District Council Public Protection Team; social media will not resolve it'



Developments in Fernwood

Housing Developments in and around Fernwood

There are three developers building or planning to build houses on the edges of our village. The planning references are as follows if you want to look these up on the Newark and Sherwood District Council website:



The first twenty homes on the Barratt David Wilson Homes (BDWH) properties have been completed. Occupations started in the Spring — we welcome the new residents to the village. The Parish Council continue to closely liaise with the developers to try to minimise disruption to Fernwood Residents. There are conditions within their planning permission which ensure construction traffic should not be coming through the village. We are keeping a log of issues so please contact the Parish Council office if you see any problems.

Larkfleet are currently working on their reserved matters application. They estimate that work will start on the roundabout at the front of their development next Spring

Persimmon Homes are currently negotiating the Section 106 agreement with Newark and Sherwood District Council. They estimate they will be onsite late 2021/early 2022.

Fernwood Parish Council is working with the District Council to ensure that there will not be a management company maintaining the open spaces in these new developments.

About Parish Council Meetings

- 1. The Full Council meets on the third Monday of each month (apart from August and December when we don't meet). Meetings are virtual using Zoom.
- 2. These meetings are open to the public so you can see the work of the Parish Council.
- 3. At the beginning of every meeting we hold a public forum where you can raise issues with the Councillors.
- 4. Agendas are published approximately a week before the meetings. These are available on the Council's website: www.fernwood-pc.co.uk and Facebook page. They are also shared to local Facebook pages.
- 5. Draft minutes are usually published a week after the meeting but are not formally agreed until the next meeting.
- 6. All minutes and the latest agenda can be found on our noticeboards and on our website: www.fernwood-pc.co.uk
- 7. Often there is a District or County Councillor present at our meetings so if you have any issues about their services, you could raise it with them.
- 8. Occasionally there is a confidential item on the agenda where observers need to leave the room.
- 9. The rules the Parish Council follow can be found on our website.

Your Parish Council

The Parish Council has three main assets in the village: the village hall, the green on Dale Crescent and the dog waste bins. The Council want to take ownership of the open spaces in Fernwood but Barratt David Wilson Homes do not want to hand over the land at this time. We

are seeking help from Newark and Sherwood District Council and our local MP to achieve this.


The Parish Council is consulted by local planning authorities on plans in and around the Parish and it liaises with other local councils and developers and businesses involved with the village.

The Parish Council has met with our local MP to lobby the government for better rights for free-holders living in villages with management companies.



Planning Applications

You will not to be surprised to hear that there is a lot of development work in and around Fernwood. To be kept up to date on these, we recommend that you use the planning tracker on the Fernwood Parish Council website. You can sign up for email alerts on the right hand side of our home page.



Fernwood Parish Council is consulted regarding planning applications but the decisions are made by Newark and Sherwood District Council. Anyone can write to Newark and Sherwood District Council regarding whether they agree or disagree with an application.

Newark and District Council's planning applications website allows you to search and view detailed information of valid applications submitted to the authority. 
