Stoneleigh road layout to be completed by end of 2025. Road closures will take place whilst tie in connections are completed. Subject to Stoneleigh Park events. The B4115 & Leamington Rod will remain open throughout.

No footpath access due to the development as no land available to redivert. HS2 cannot provide a safe alternative route until completion of works. The verge cannot be redesigned as too narrow, Sara Louise will ask again for possible alternatives.
