## Policy WB1 – Wallop Brook

a) To review the latest draft of Policy WB1

Version as of August 2020:

DRAFT POLICY WB1 — Environmental Protection & Enhancement of the Wallop Brook

- 1) Development proposals must conserve or enhance wildlife habitats and biodiversity of the Wallop Brook and its associated riparian environment, including creating links between habitats to improve connectivity.
- 2) Development proposals that would result in an adverse effect on the Wallop Brook, which cannot either be avoided or adequately mitigated will be refused.
- 3) Where development may impact important habitats associated with the Wallop Brook, it should be demonstrated that the development would have a positive impact on those habitats. A suitable long term management plan will be required.

Action from WG Meeting on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021 - ALL COMPARE TO PREVIOUS VERSION AND REVERT WITH COMMENTS **REVISED POLICY WB1** — Environmental Protection & Enhancement of the Wallop Brook Development proposals must conserve or enhance wildlife habitats and biodiversity of 1) Wallop Brook and its associated riparian environment, including creating links between habitats to improve connectivity. 2) Maintain and enhance the key characteristic associated with the Wallop Brook, including braided channels, drainage ditches, mill streams and pools, weirs and leats. 3) Restore and protect historic Bridges, and enhance the sense of place of crossing points over the Wallop Brook. 4) Improve access to and interpretation of the historic features of the Wallop Brook, so that the public can visit and understand them. 5) Where practical, restore features such as water meadows and mills to a working state for commercial or educational purposes. 6) Development proposals that would result in an adverse effect on the Wallop Brook, which cannot either be avoided or adequately mitigated will be refused.

7) Where development may impact important habitats associated with the Wallop Brook, it should be demonstrated that the development would have a positive impact on those habitats. A suitable long term management plan will be required.
