# b. Sanding and painting of benches

It was agreed to hire a sander at a cost not to exceed £100.00.

It was decided to ask a contractor to quote to replace the bench seat.

#### c. Rotation of wooden slates

Members decided that a further 20 slates could be turned and sanded (if appropriate). Cllr Keating would ask Full Council for £300.00 from reserves at the next Full Council meeting.
