- 2 Shaded area - shaded area or canopy for parents and children in the Summer/Winter months
- 2 More seating - picnic benches or normal benches for elderly or families to use for picnic.
- 9 Forest Play Equipment in The Chestnuts area
- 4 Table Tennis Table
