# Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022 <u>At Stoneleigh Village Hall</u>

# 32. Apologies and Acceptance of Apologies

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Bianco, Cllr Jack, Cllr P Redford and Cllr W Redford.

#### 33. Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

#### 32. Minutes of the last meeting

Minutes of the Ordinary meeting of 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and the Annual Parish Council meeting were approved.

#### 33. Public Session

Standing orders were suspended at 7.05pm.

A member of the public enquired if there had been any issues with The Kenilworth Show. It was reported that the event was well attended, there was traffic management on site and no issues with parking.

A member of the public asked about the Birmingham Road closure plan.

It was explained that there will be 4-way 'urban64' traffic lights installed at the crossroads for approximately 18 months. During this time the Parish Council and Warwickshire County Council will continue to progress with the TRO. HS2 have agreed to amend the traffic signals when the road is closed.

WCC have instructed the drafting of the experimental TRO (the legal order that allows for the road to be closed). They have suggested the timeline for the closure will be later this year or early next year. Once the road has closed WCC and stakeholders will monitor the surrounding roads. If there is no increase in accidents, congestion or complaint, the order will automatically become permanent. WCC would then have to put a permanent measure in

place. The Parish Council would also encourage reports from residents on the effects of the road closure.

The project is waiting for the design to be finalised and agreement from the school buses and public bus companies.

A member of the public asked why there was a digger on the crossroads. It was explained that the construction of the monopole had commenced.

Standing orders were reinstated at 7.20pm.

# 36. Stoneleigh Park events

Cllr Wright provided the meeting with the following feedback received from the recent Safety Advisory Group (SAG) meeting:

It was stated that there seems to be a concerted effort by the event organisers to work with partners and keep disturbance to a minimum this year. The Community Safety Officer was satisfied with the approach they intend to take to prevent the issues that arose at last year's event

#### Key points highlighted:

- Event organisers will be using social media to advise attendees not to commute through Stoneleigh Village.
- Signage will be in place in strategic positions to inform attendees not to drive through Stoneleigh Village.
- Staff from the event site will be positioned along the road network to advise attendees not to drive through Stoneleigh Village.
- A total of three car parks will be provided for attendees to use (1 last year).
- Different entrances to the event will be utilised to prevent traffic build up at the main entrance.
- Event organisers are calling on attendees to drive in a lawful and sensible manner at all times.
- Warwickshire Police will have an operation in place for the duration of the event to deal with any ASB encountered this will include seizing vehicles driven in an antisocial manner.
- There will be no overnight camping/accommodation on site.

The Parish Council asked that Cllr Wright request some additional signs on the B4115 approaches to the two roads in to the village of Ashow.

Cllr Wright agreed to find out who the key contact is for Stoneleigh events and to obtain a copy of the traffic management drawings (CAD) for all of the signs that will be used.

The Parish Council thought that it would be useful to ask PCSO Ed King for a link to the operational police, so that residents are able to report incidents.

The Clerk has a meeting with the Head of Finance at Stoneleigh Park on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 to hopefully start a dialogue with the events team.

# 41. Community Speed Watch

PCSO Ed King has, through the S&A News advert, been contacted by three members of the public willing to volunteer for the Community Speed Watch scheme.

Standing orders were suspended at 8.20pm.

A member of the public asked if the Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) outside the Village Hall is going to be repaired.

The clerk reported the damaged VAS to Warwickshire County Council. WCC are close to completing a policy regarding VAS's in Warwickshire. It is likely that this will result in some VAS's being removed when they fail. If the damaged VAS is to be retained, WCC will look at reinstating it.

Standing orders were reinstated at 8.23pm.

# 42. Updates from Warwickshire Police, WCC Cllr Redford and WDC Councillors P Redford and T Wright

Warwickshire Police sent a crime report to the Parish Council – appendices 1.

Cllr Wright (WDC) informed the meeting that vehicle theft is on the rise, and that certain vehicles are being targeted. He also reported an increase in the high jacking of vehicles.

Cllr Wright reported that the Jubilee celebrations had gone well and details of the Birmingham Games are being released.

The new 123+ bin scheme information has been released. Cllr Wright stated that there is a scheme to provide an extra bin to people registered with certain health conditions and there

is a process for needles and sharps to be collected. Cllr Wright also informed the parish Council that the current red bins will not be collected.

# 43. Correspondence

Letter received from CPRE informing that they did not succeed with the court case to stop the proposed development of housing in green field sites adjacent to Coventry. The recent donation by the Parish Council will be refunded.

Resident complaint concerning a recent event at Stoneleigh Village Hall. The Parish Council contacted the trustees of the hall who apologised and explained that the event was a 'one-off' and it had prompted them to relook at their Conditions of Hire.

Royal Mail have extended our PO Box service for four months as original instructions sent by the clerk went missing and so staff were not aware of the PO Box.
