

OVERNIGHT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A37 STRATTON BYPASS, STRATTON

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A37 Stratton Bypass, Stratton between Dorchester Road and Ash Hill (in both directions), a distance of approximately 330 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation at 21:00 on 5th January 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 05:00 on 6th January 2022.

This Notice will enable Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd safe access to undertake bridge inspections

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A37, A30, A352 and vice versa.
