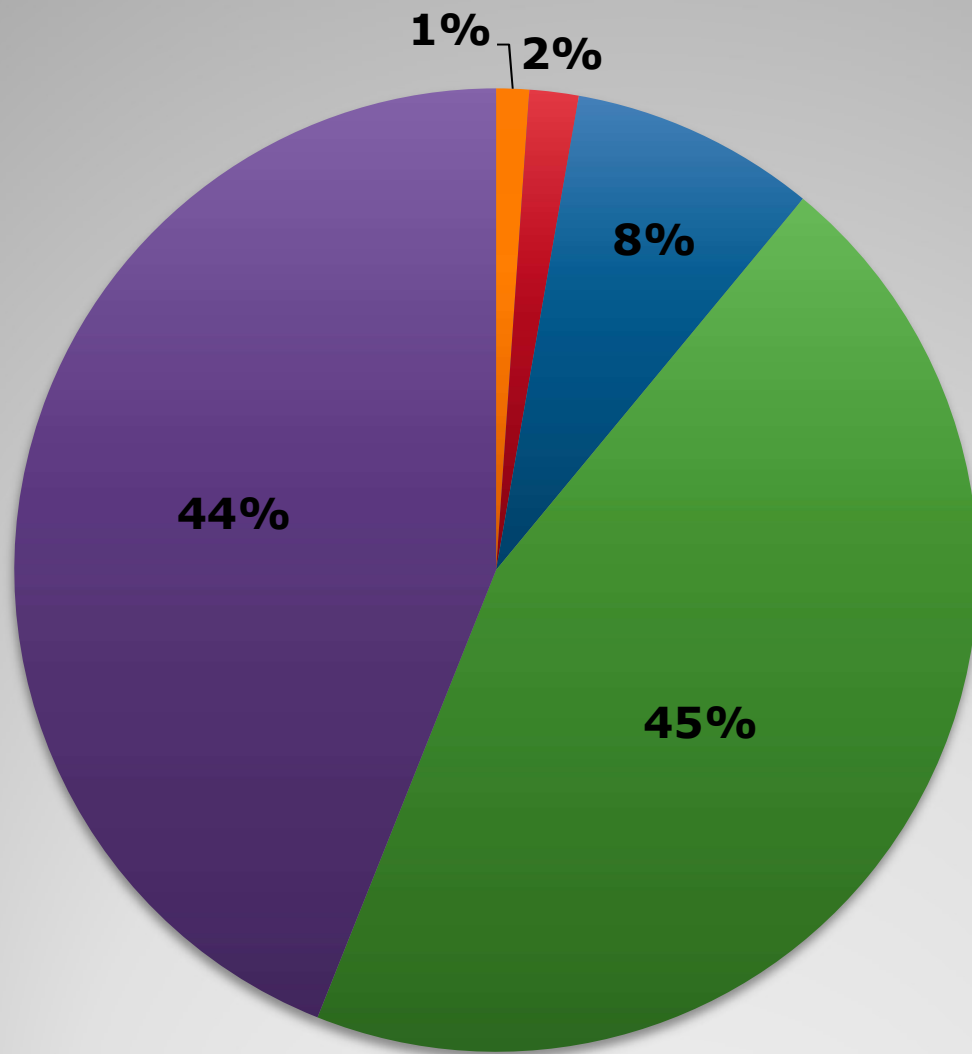


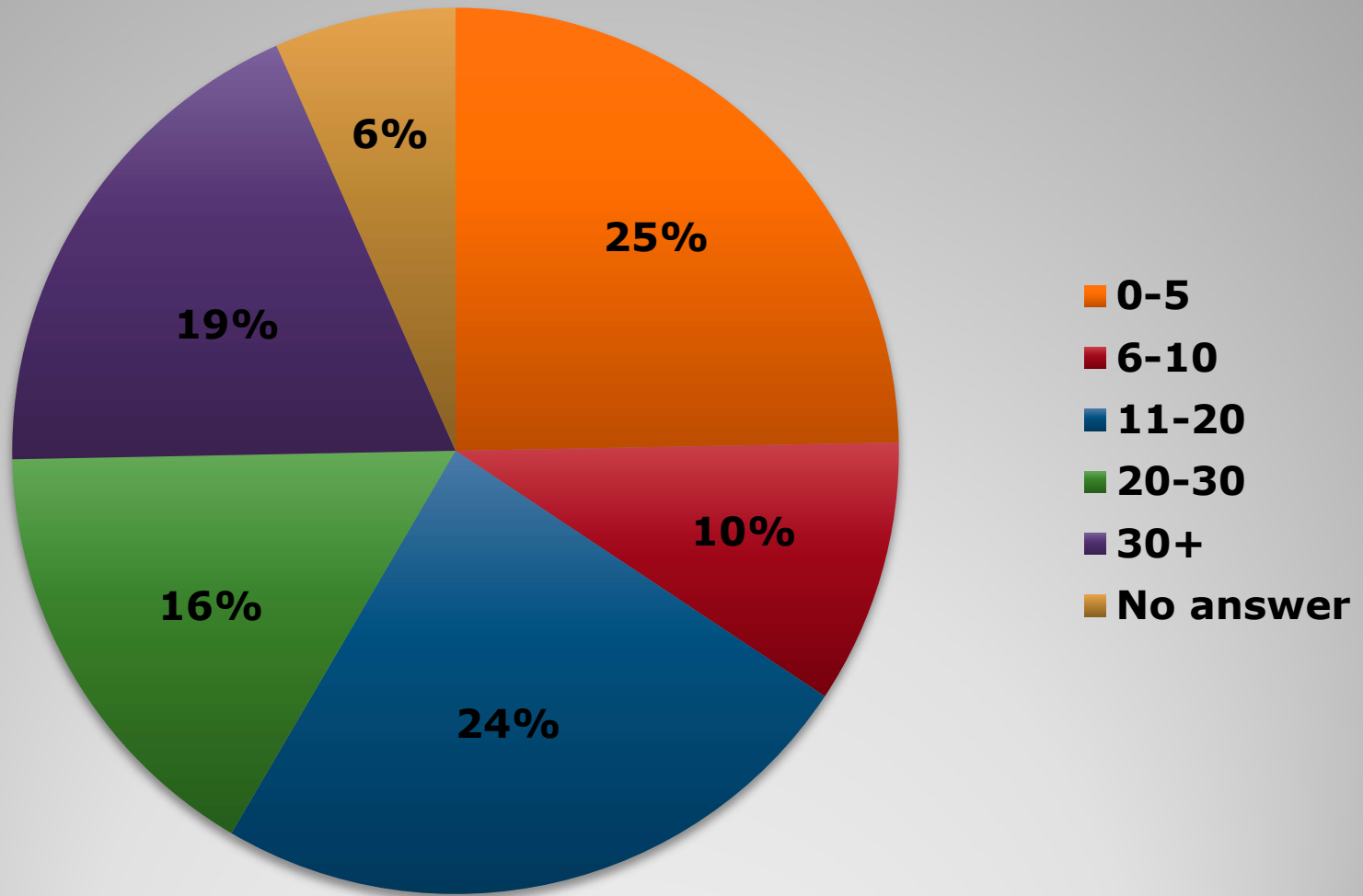

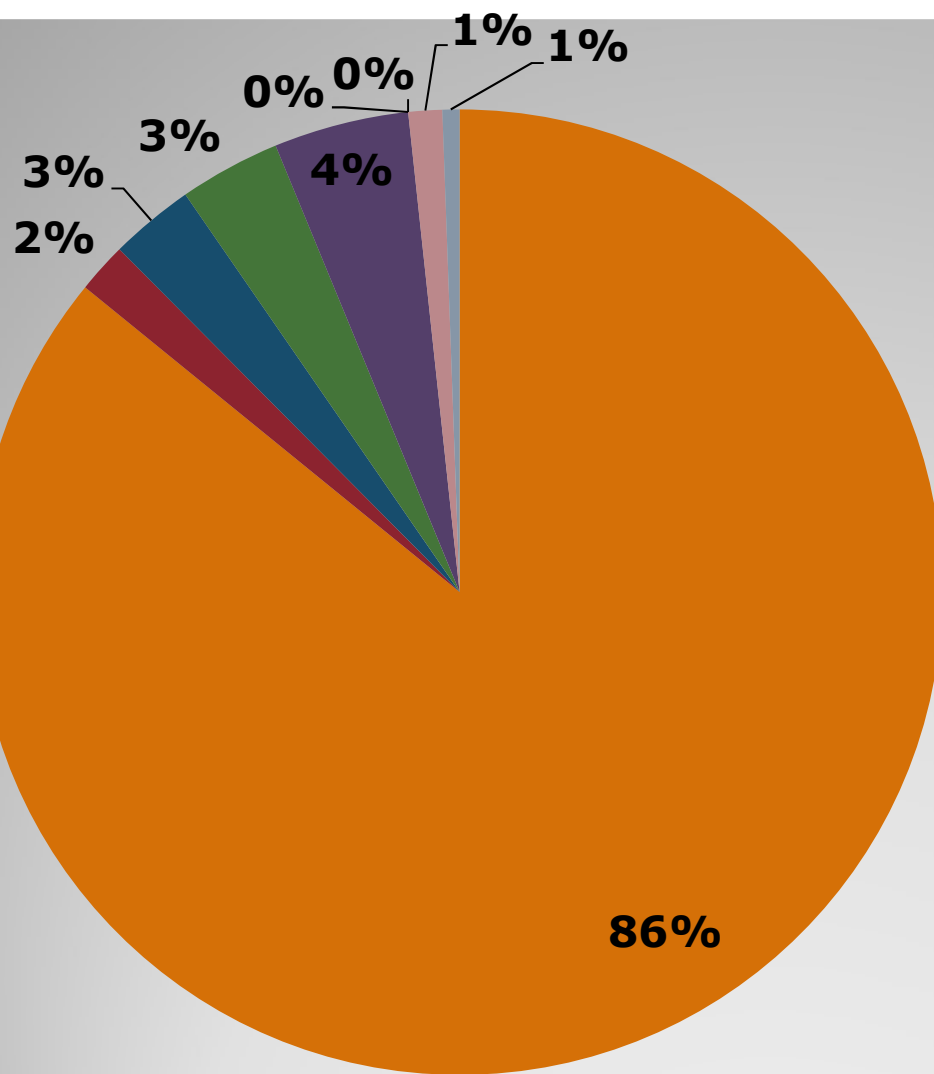

Age Distribution

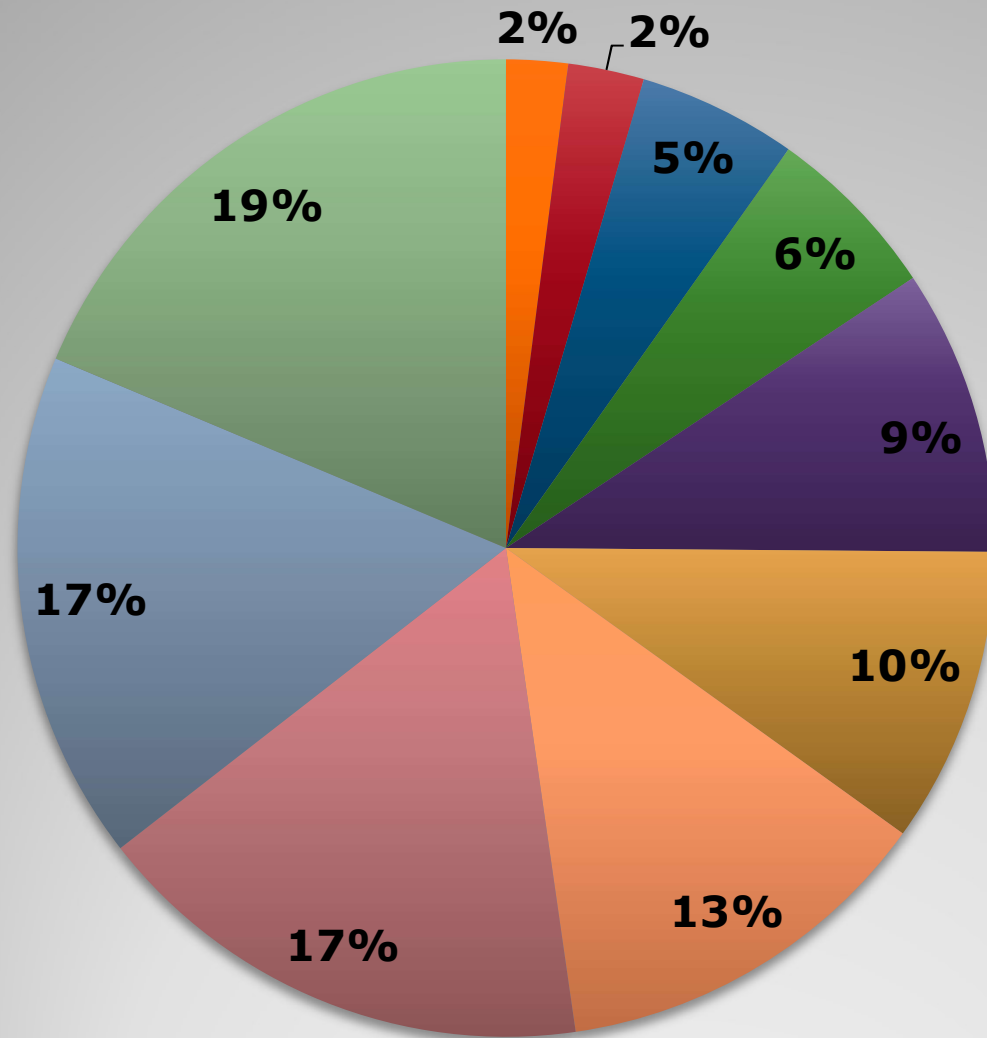


Years in Parish



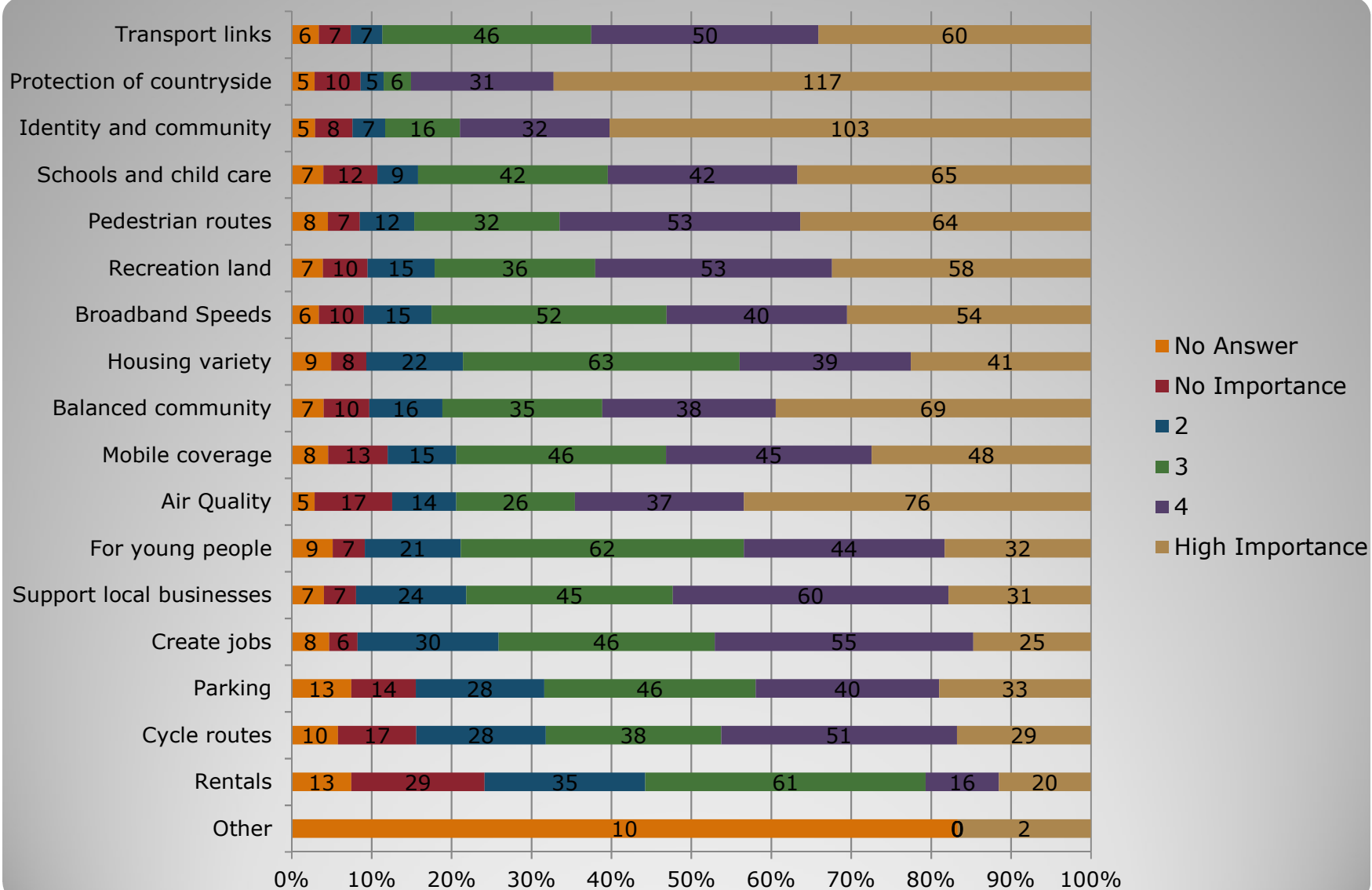

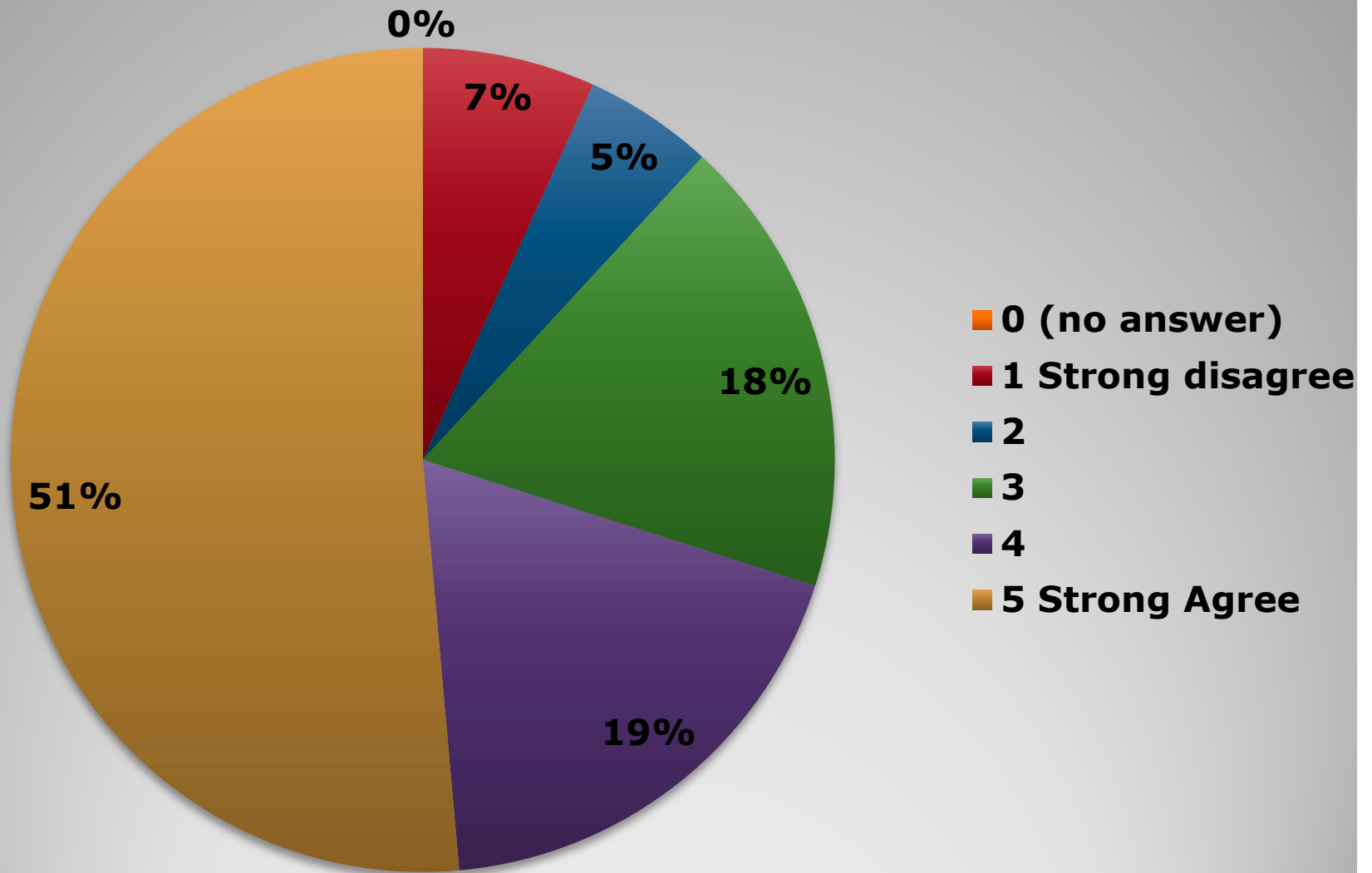

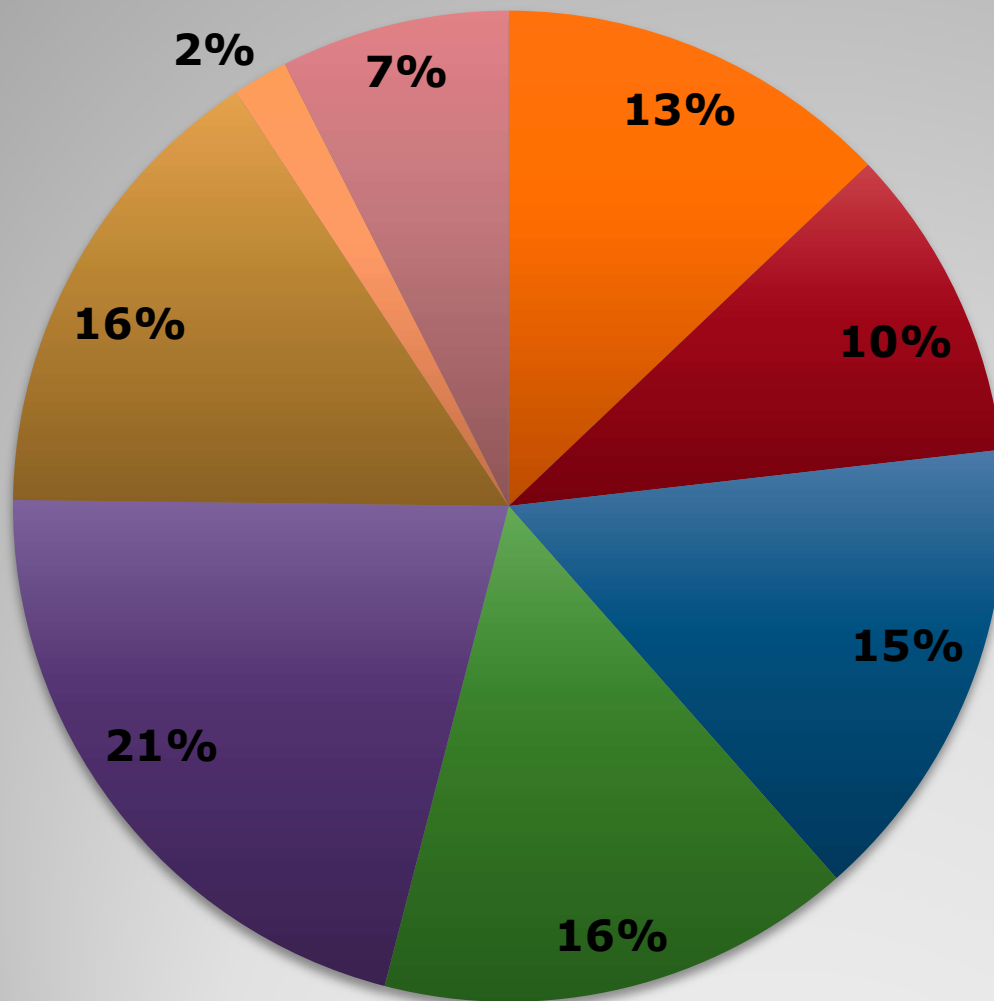

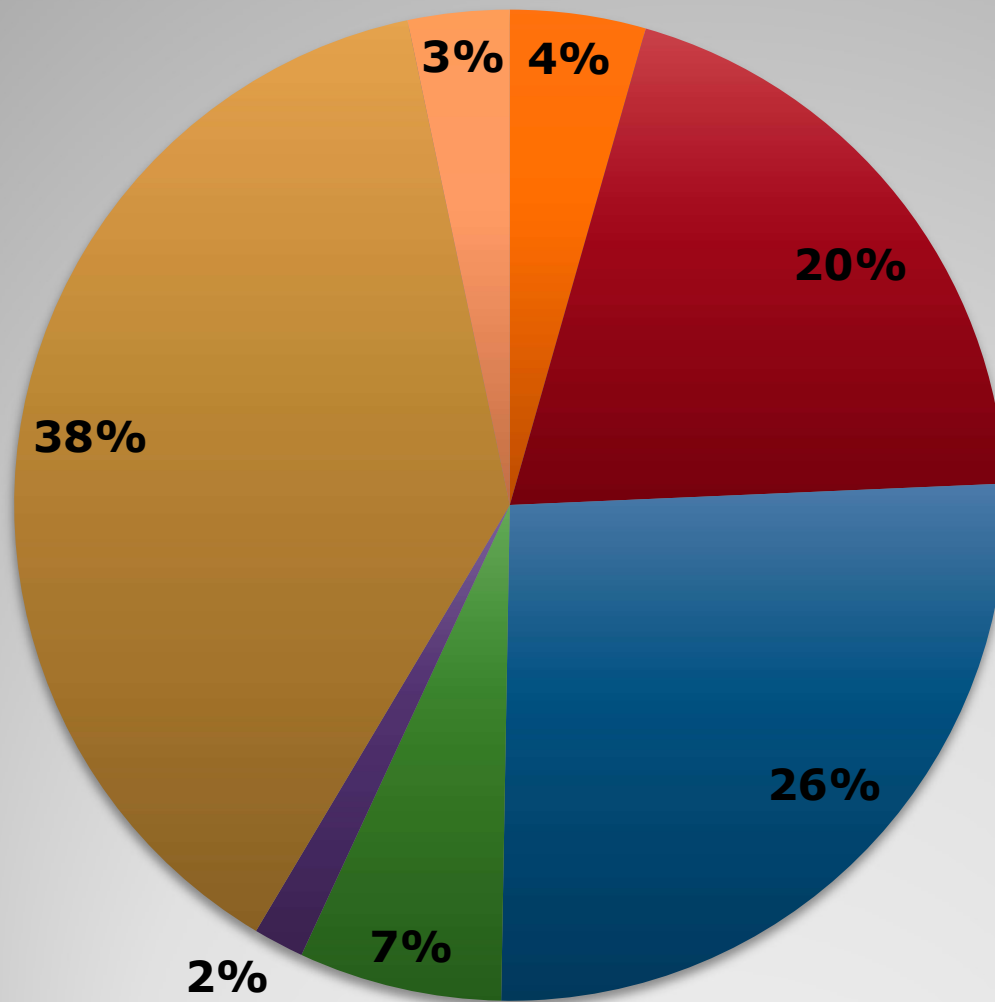

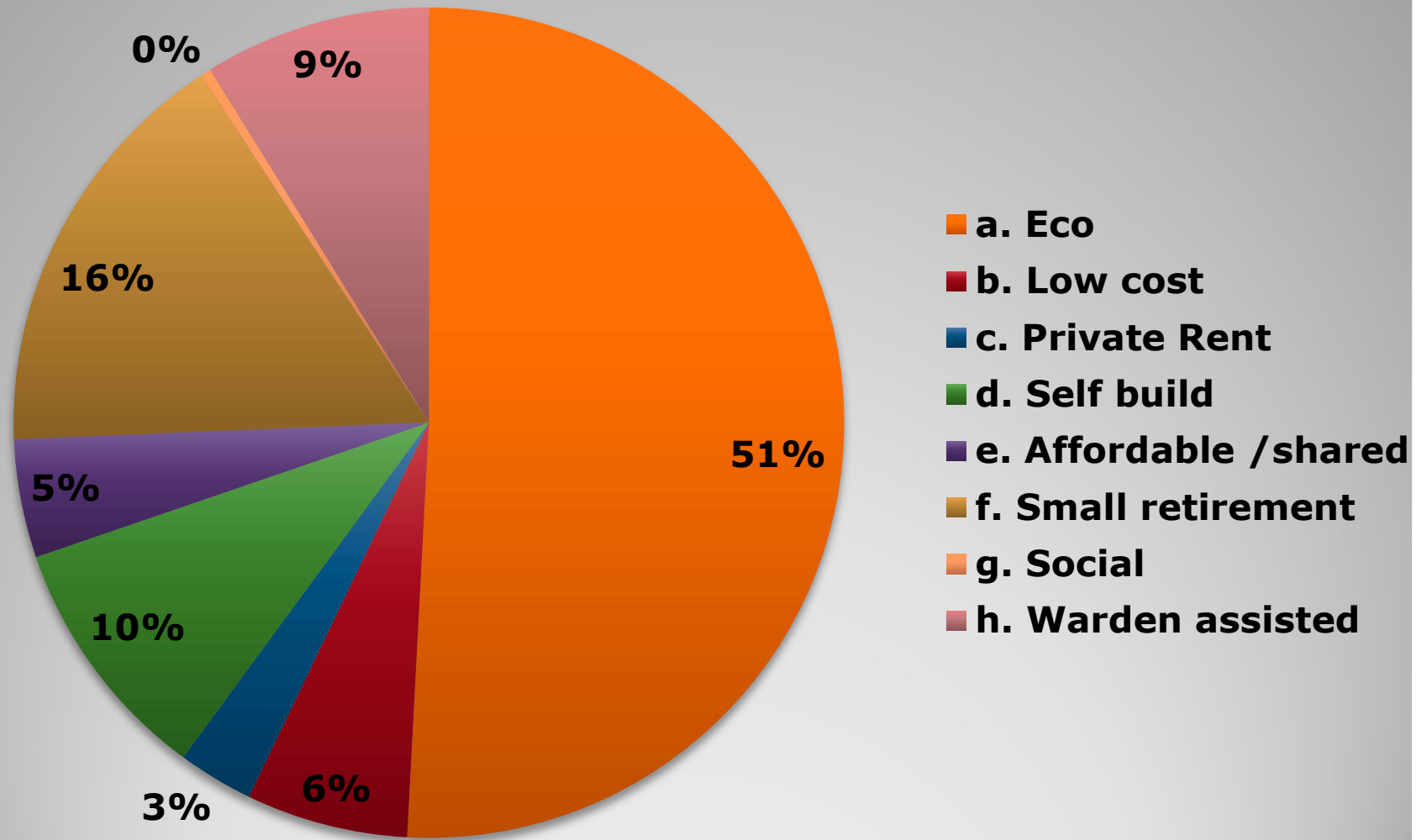

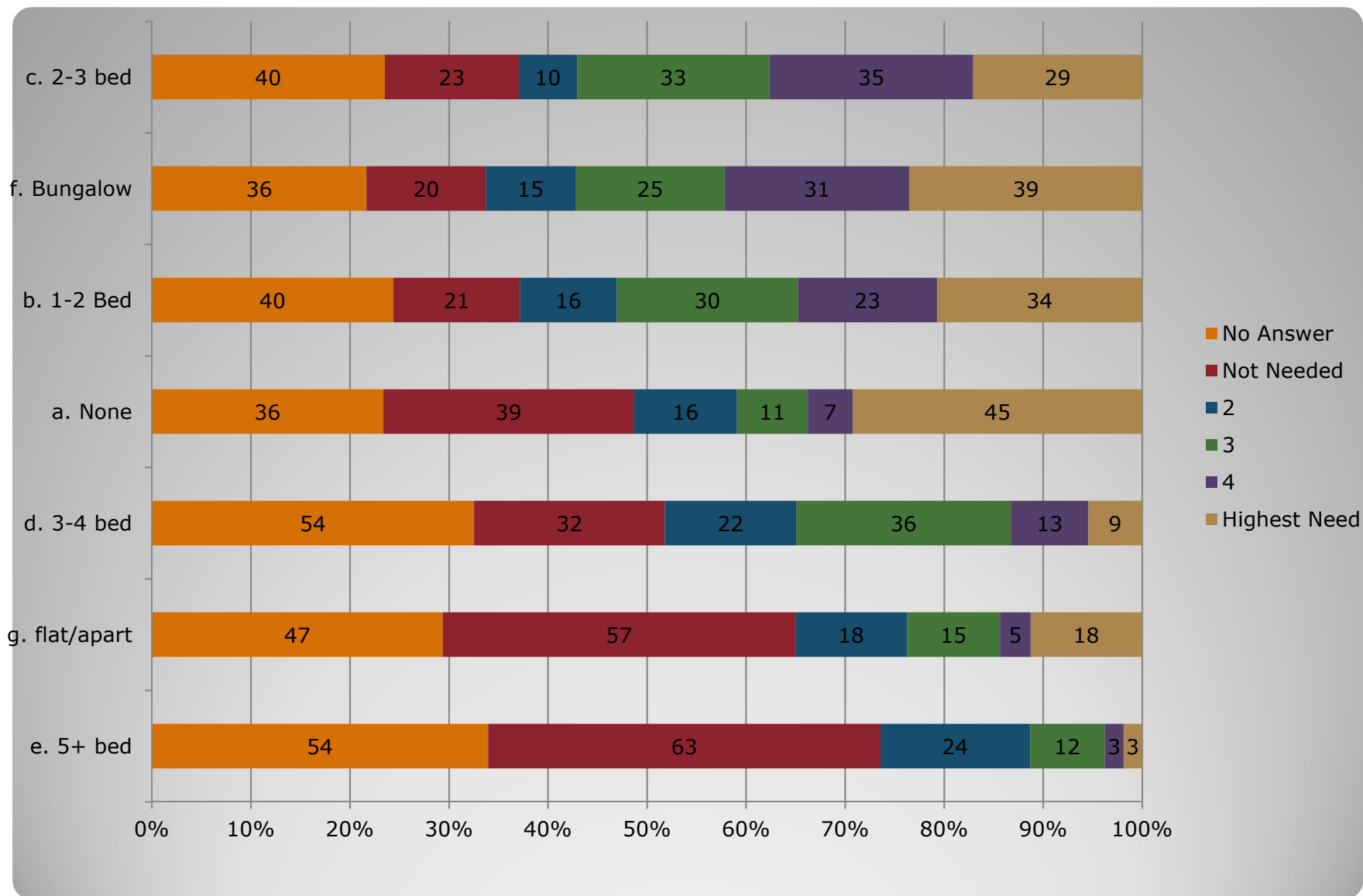

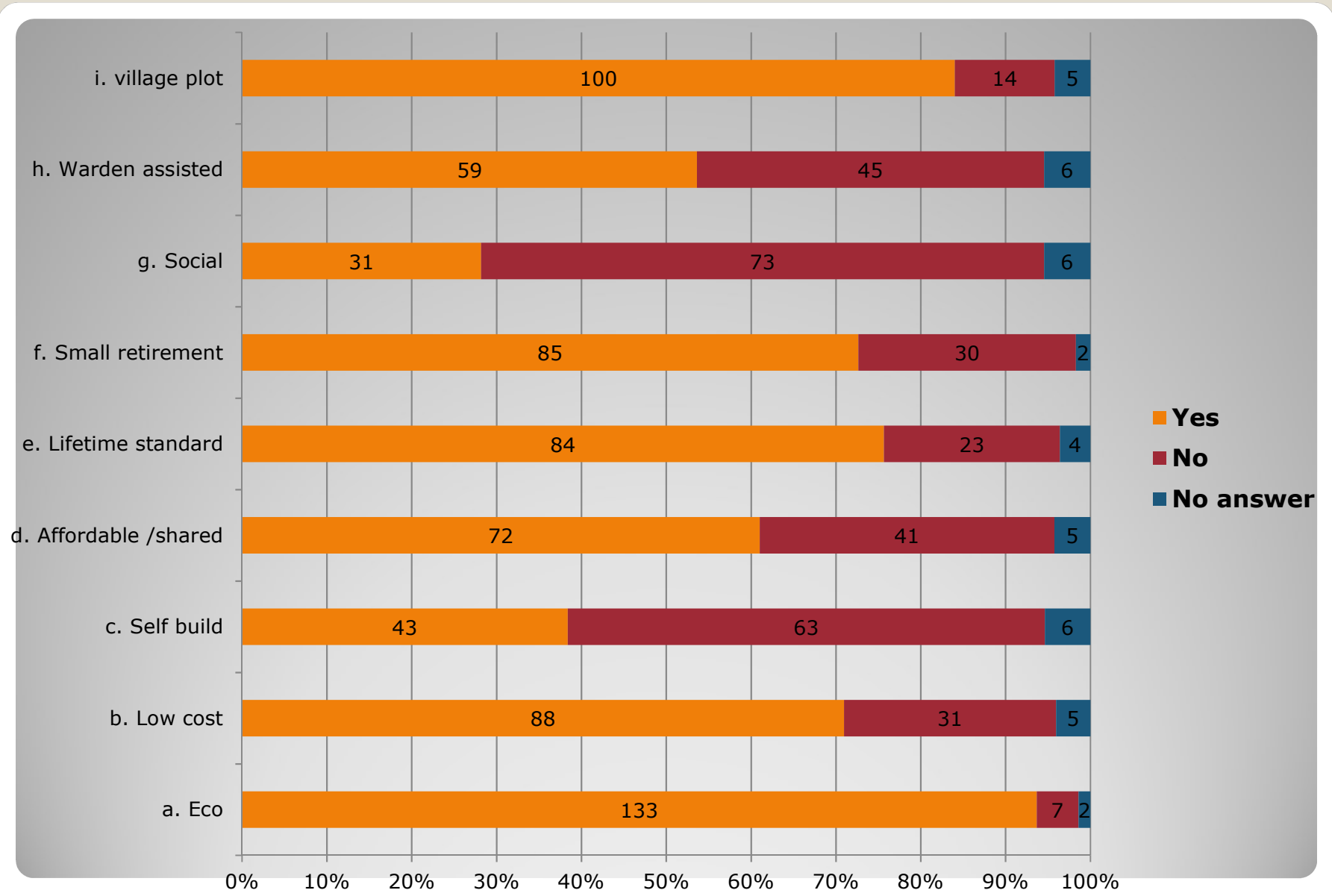

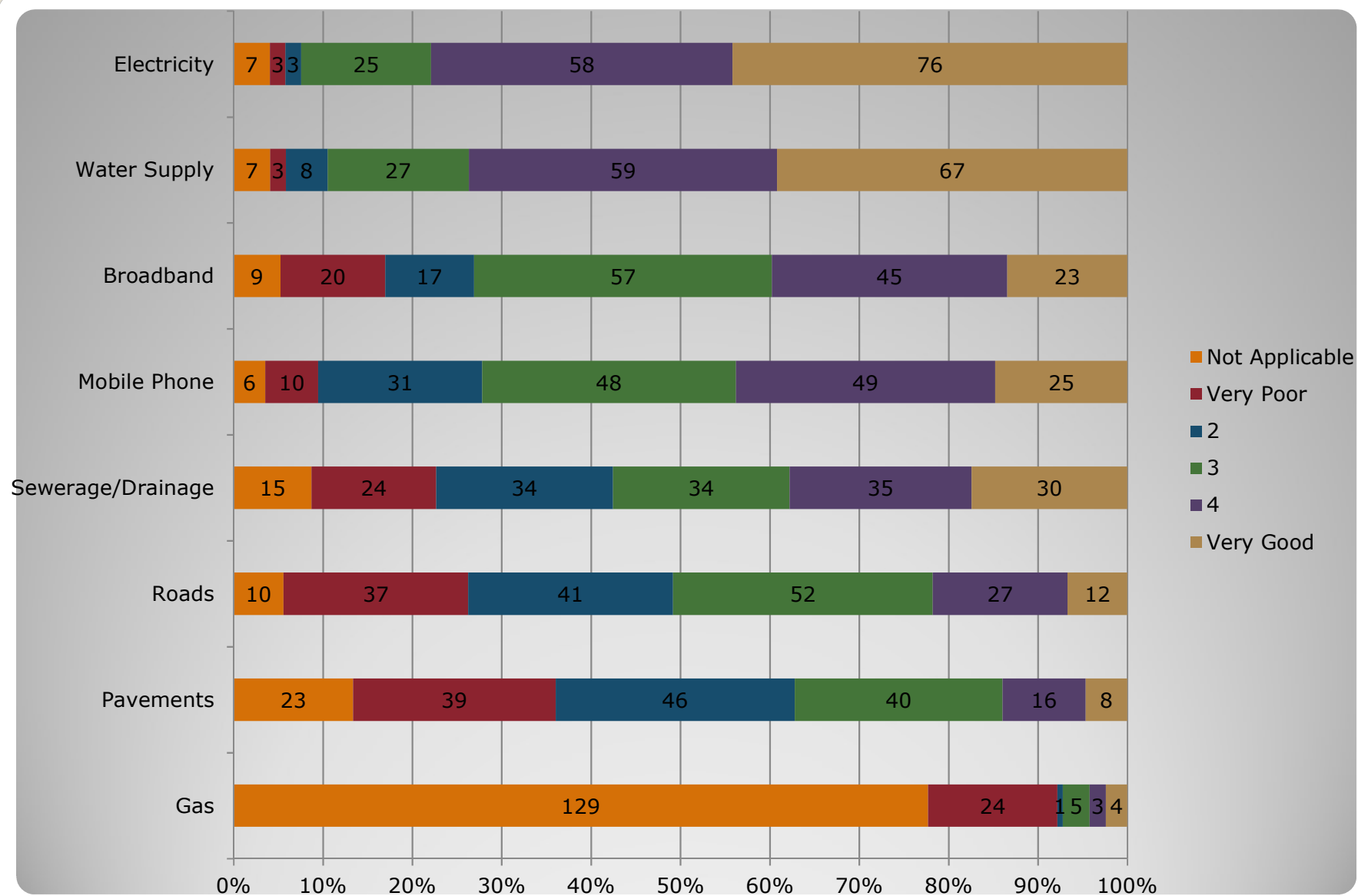

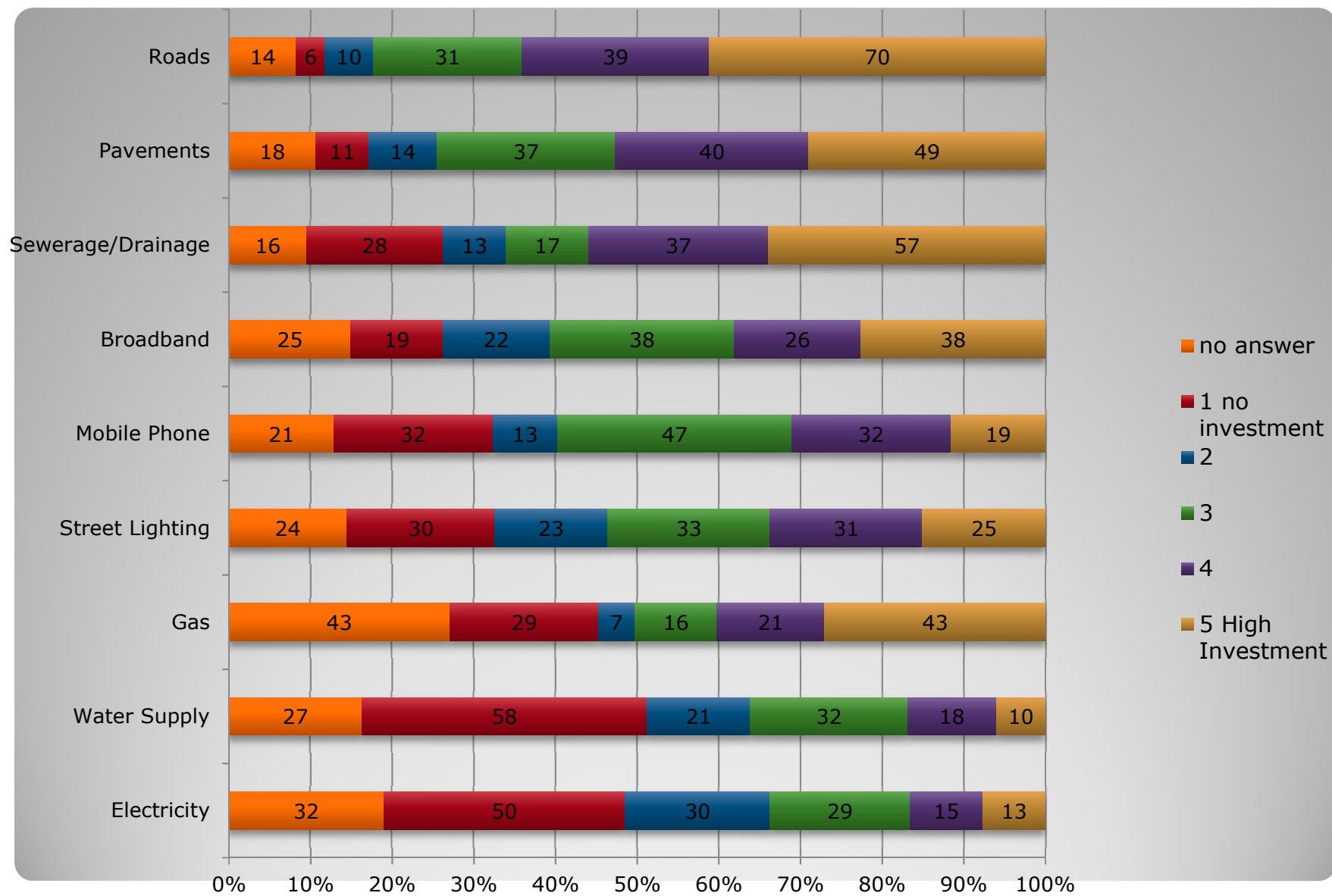

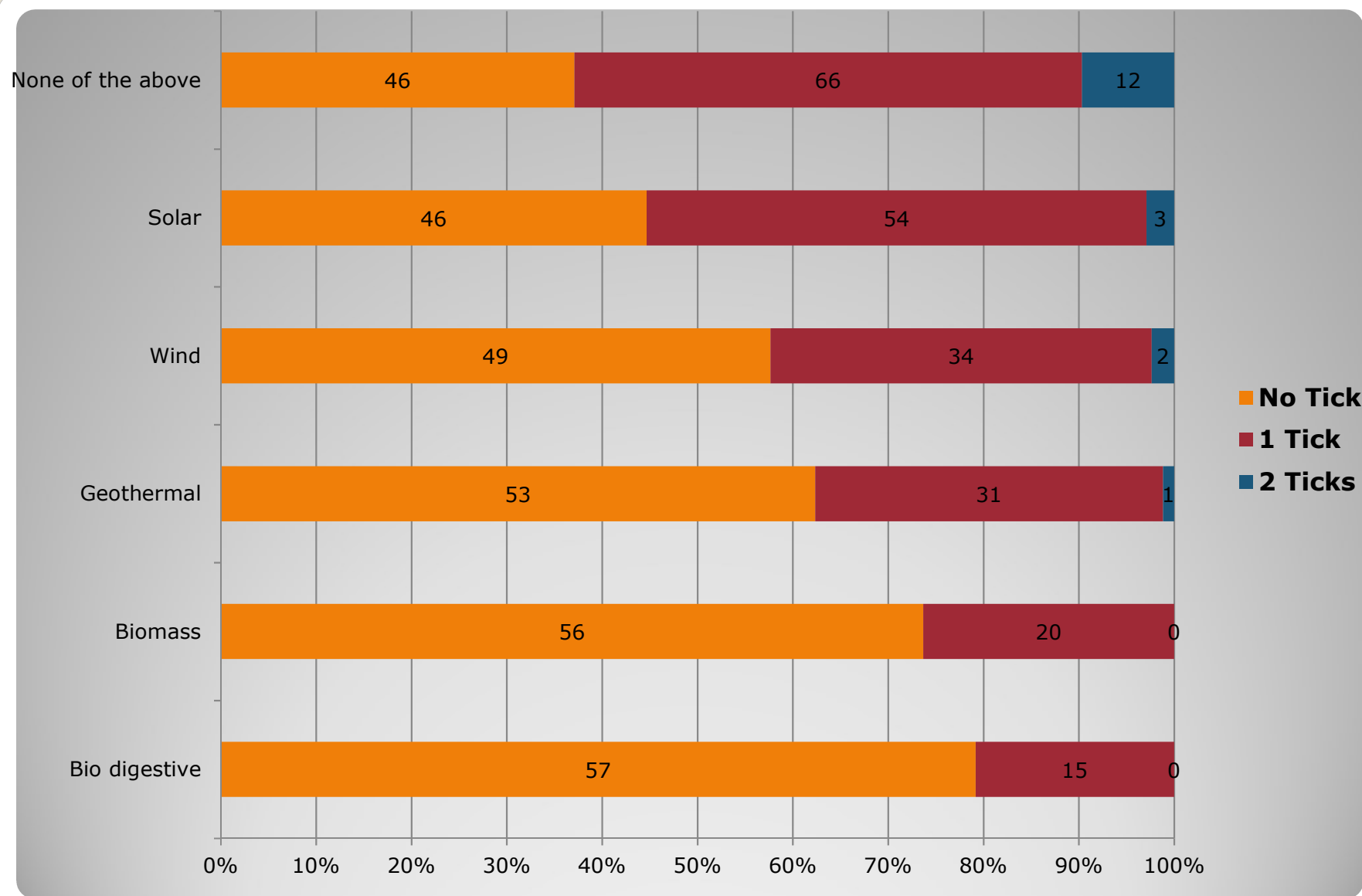

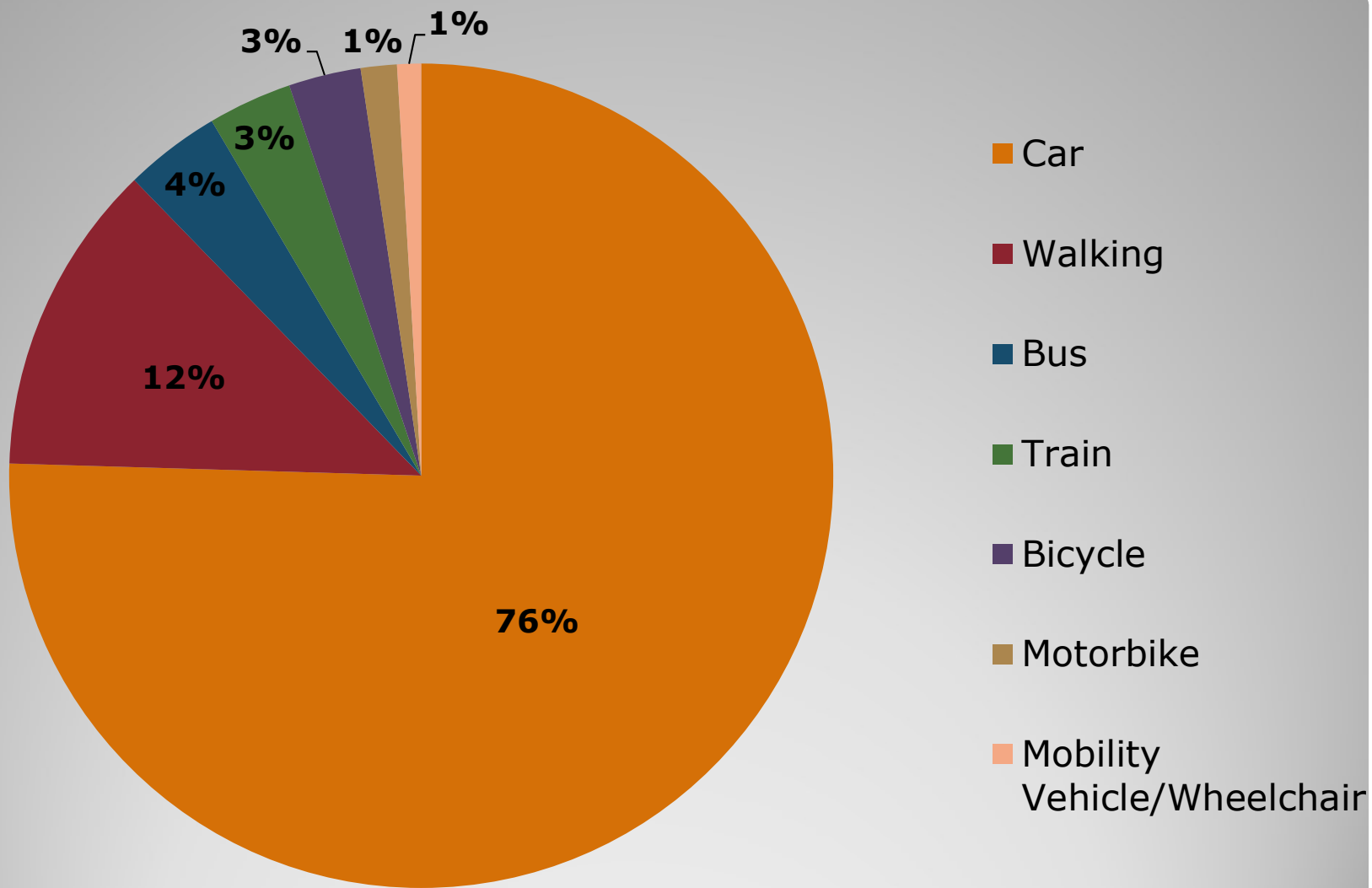

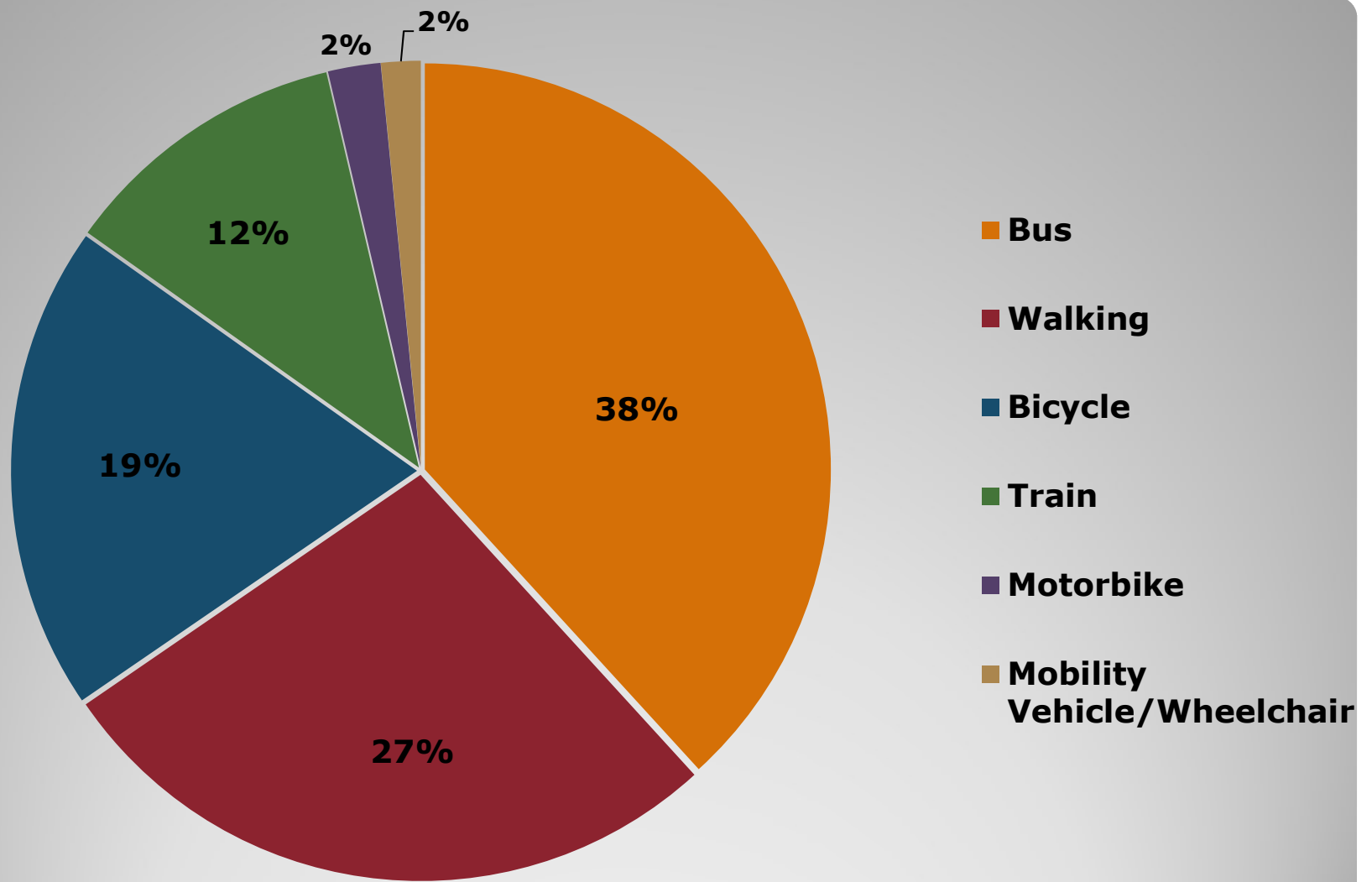

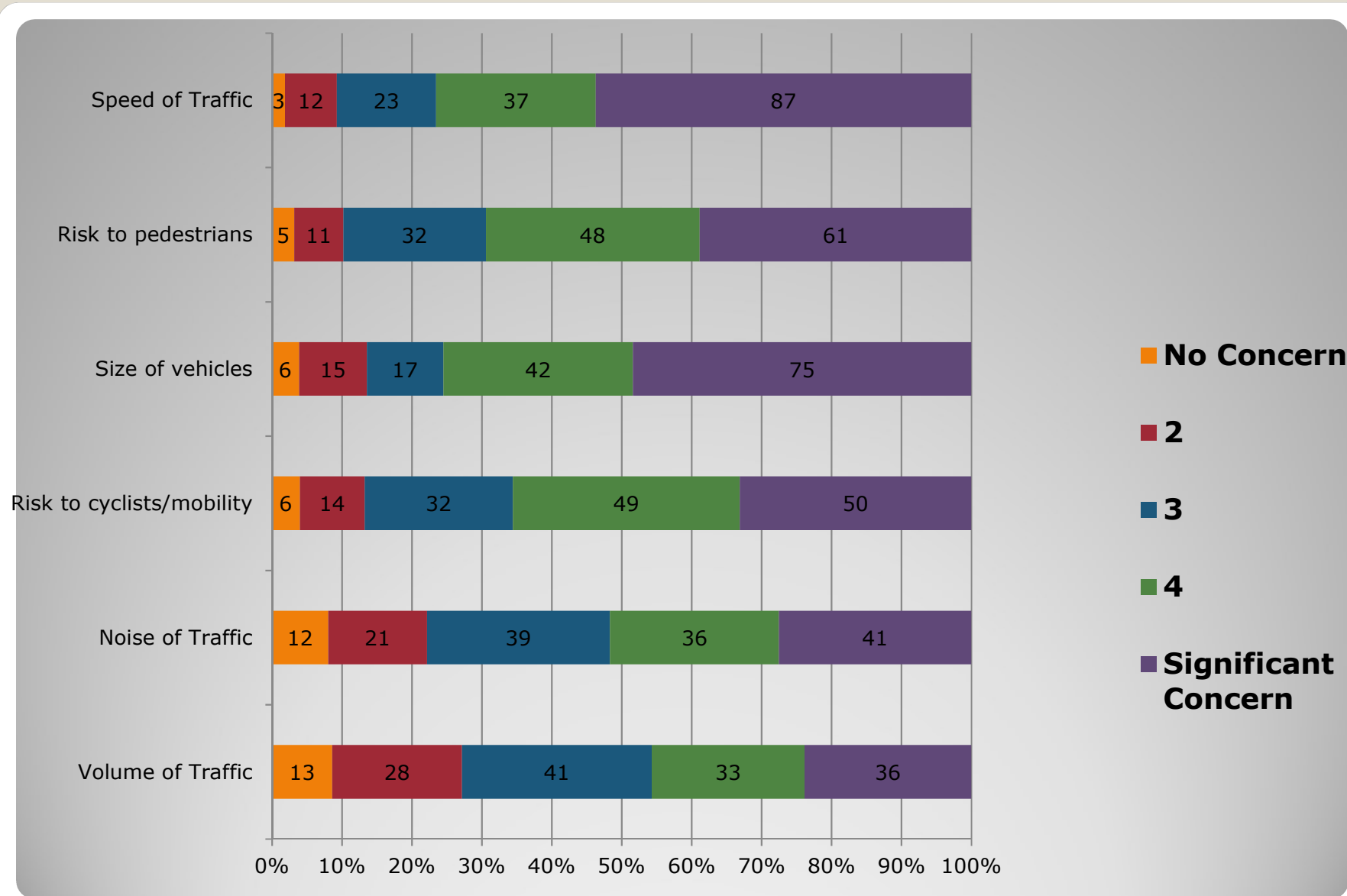

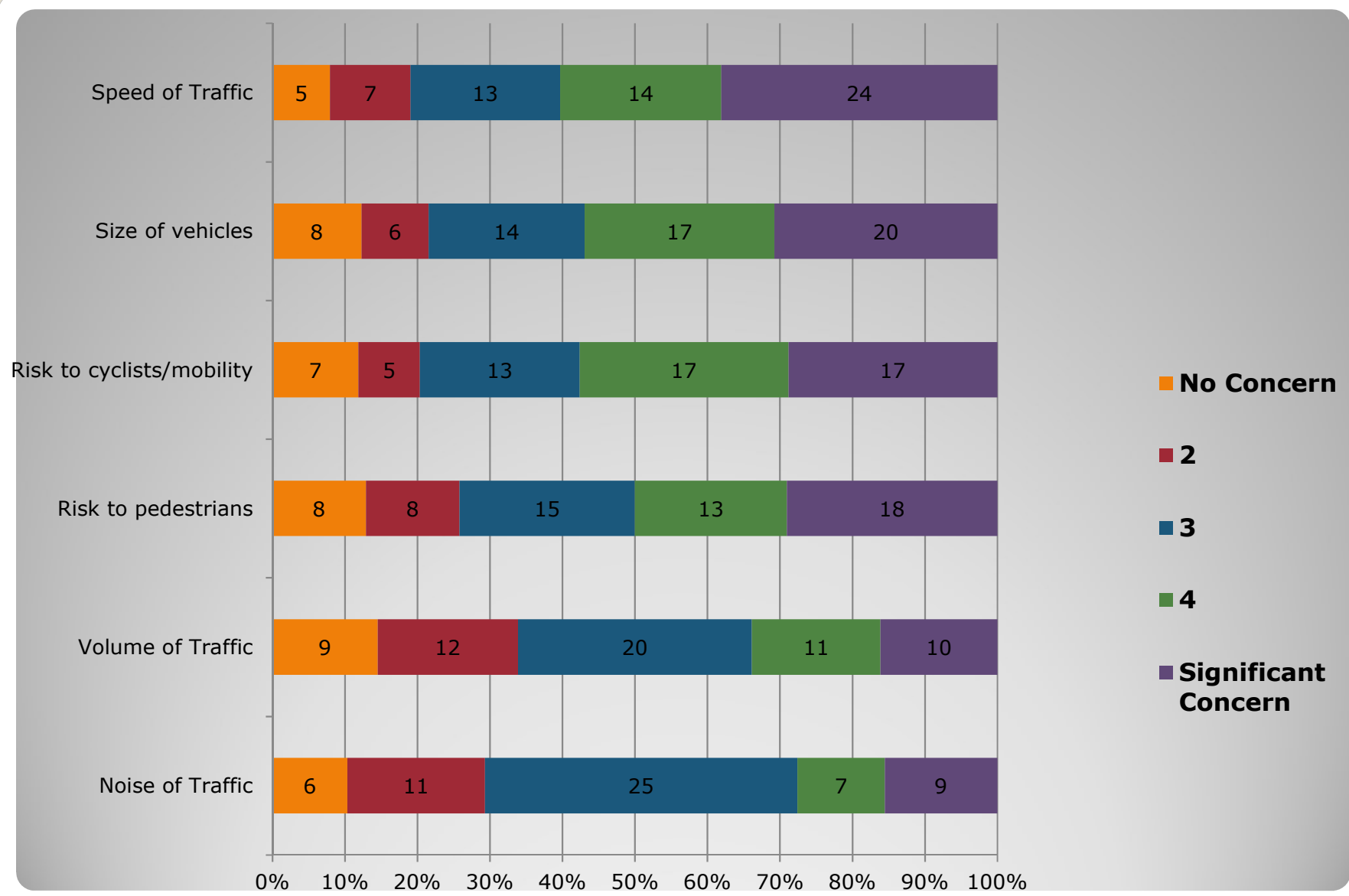
Form of Transport most used?



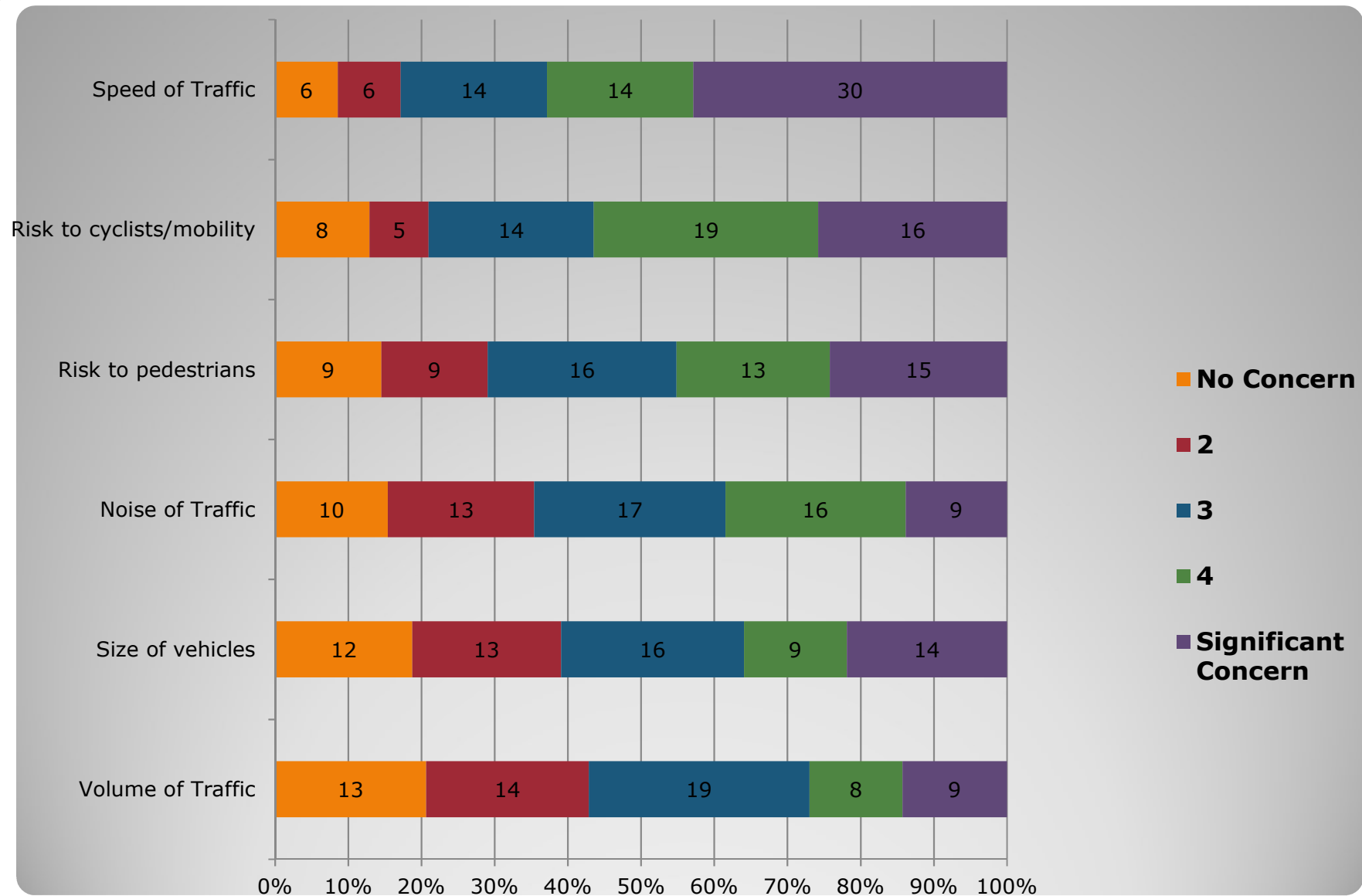

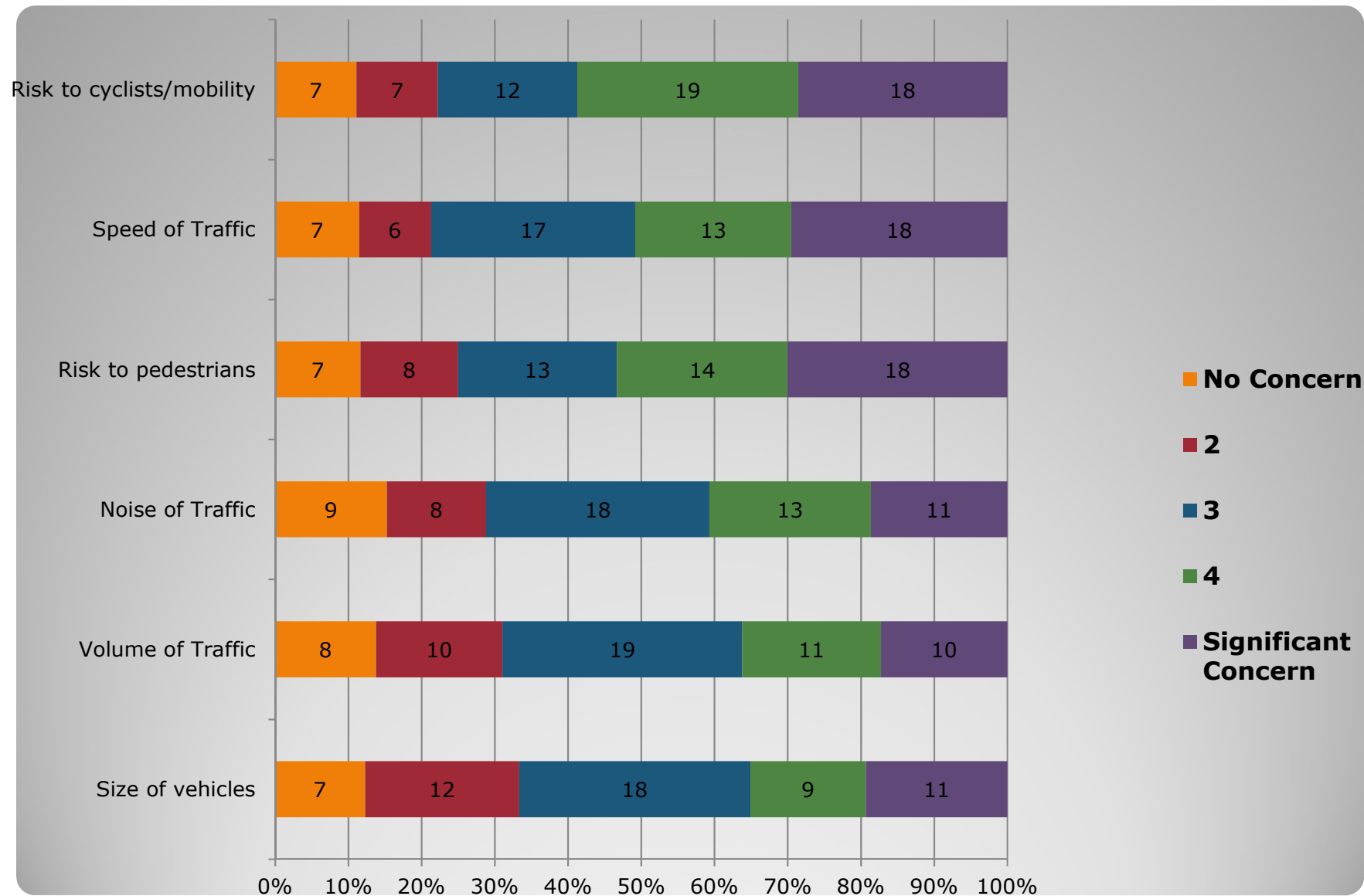

Any development must remember Thruxton is a village so it must be balanced and limited

Any development must have minimal visual impact

The village needs new blood

Not desirable to become a purely retirement village since for a proper community we need a wide range of ages

The absolute priority should be to retain Thruxton as a rural village community, NOT a suburb of Andover

The requirement should be based on need, not greed

No housing

Need to ensure that the children of current residents of Thruxton can afford to live in the area if wished

The back road to the Industrial Estate is used as a tip; housing here would stop this
