Minutes of the previous meeting were signed as a true and correct record after amending footpath Manor Fields to Machins

Village Hall

Cars are again being parked on the Village Hall car park, clerk to write again, saying although the problem did improve, it has deteriorated again

Sound baffling – agreed to look into after the roof has been done. Mrs Godfrey to look into costs

The clerk and electrician have been looking at alternative heating

Grant

Agreed that Mr Paris and Mrs Godfrey would be the authorised signatories for the grant application

Roads and hedges

Again speeding motorbikes were raised, agreed to put in the Village news that homeowners should contact Environmental Health, if they have concerns over noise and unsocial behaviour

The new cross roads sign near the School is being moved across the road to the end of Back Lane

Street lights are being changed to white as they are more economical – a letter was read out concerning the light on Radley Road, stating it was too bright and shone in windows, Cllr Laughton to look into having it turned down or baffles fitted to make the light shine down not out

Clerk to contact Cllr Rainbow as Safer Neighbourhood Chairman, to see if we can have the mobile speed van in the village

The clerk met with the new footpaths officer, Rachael Rickell and had a walk round the village, she will look into having repairs done where necessary

Clerk to contact Norwood Golf Course, about the overhanging hedge on School Lane

Harvest Supper

A good night was had, there has been plenty of positive feedback, we raised £318.20

Speed Watch

PCSO Keith Crowhurst will attend the November meeting to talk about Speed Watch and see if we will restart

The Waggon and Horses has offered the field adjacent to the car park as a space for the Village to hold events. The Landlord will be approached to see if they would be happy for children to use an open space, the insurance and health and safety would need looking into further

Dog/litter bin

After discussion the footpath sign at the entrance to Manor Fields was suggested as somewhere to put the dog bin, clerk to make enquiries
