Face coverings must be worn at all times when inside the building. In the introduction to the meeting the Chairman will explain the COVID-19 restrictions and guidance for attendees.

Members of the public should not arrive until at least five minutes before the advertised meeting start time. Meetings shall be kept as short as possible to reduce the risk of transmission.
