Reporting back

The use of emergency CPR is so important and can give someone a 75% better chance of living if administered with the use of a defibrillator

Lilleshall Parish now has four defibrillators and as part of this rollout we've been working with West Midlands Ambulance Service and West Mercia Police to deliver emergency CPR training sessions to increase your confidence if you ever need to use a defibrillator.

The parish council is very grateful to those who attended our latest training session.

Following increasing concerns of anti social behaviour on Lilleshall Hill the parish council has been working with Telford & Wrekin Council and Borough Councillor Andrew Eade to secure funding for a surveillance system to be installed on Hillside Eade at the entrance to this road.

Contractors are due to be on site to install a CCTV system in September and surveillance will be monitored by Telford & Wrekin Council and the Police.

We are keen to hear your view on safety in the community and encourage residents to speak with your local parish councillors about your concerns.

Not sure what a parish council is?

Don't worry, that question is more common than you think, but we're here to help you understand...

- Parish councils are your most local level of government and they elect Councillors who represent you and look after some local council services.
- They represent your parish only, there will be other parishes surrounding yours so it's worth having a look here: www.gov.uk/find-local-council
- . We are not part of any church, despite the use of "parish" in our name.
- When issues are found in the area, such as dog fouling, speeding, lack of library services or allotments, we're here to look into those things for you and try resolve or improve them.
- Quite often, our Councillors are not paid, they're volunteers who meet regularly to discuss issues in the local area and come up with solutions.
- Councillors are supported by paid staff, who oversee the day to day running of the council and to carry out the decisions of the Councillors. All councils have a Clerk (Head of Paid Service), some have more staff.

There's a lot more to your parish council than meets the eye, so why not drop in on your next council meeting or contact your Councillor. Or even think about joining your council and representing your community!
