Discussion	<p>Grants were still being sought for new playground equipment. Cllr Clayton had been using the Kent Community website to identify possible grants available. Some would require matching funding from the PC which was feasible. He was also re-writing the Lottery funding application. Cllr Tee said that NVE might be interested in helping with funding. Cllr Clayton said one big problem was that, as a Parish Council, we were able to get funding from the Precept. The providers of the adult fitness equipment were still a possible source of assistance.</p> <p>Further work was required on the steps opposite the Royal Oak leading to the playing field.
