Double celebration for Jubilee as we are honored with the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service

Initial feedback from our FLOURISH (Horticulture Therapy)
Project, is very positive – with good outcomes being measured for all those taking part either at the Sensory Garden session on Sunday afternoon or at the Allotment, from April – June 2022. An extension to sessions to increase access to this therapeutic approach is planned for Community Centre Gardening & interim results due to be presented to NHS Networking conference event in early July 2022.



Plans for the future, include an extension to the Sensory Garden by planting more 'insect-friendly' shrubs and bulbs around the entire perimeter of the Town Park. Not only will this provide an interesting and accessible walk for our members, the increase to biodiversity within the Park will be enjoyed by all visitors.
