## **2/17/13. Risk Review & Asset Inspection**

### **a. Accidents.**

Details of an accident which happened on the 17<sup>th</sup> of January 2017 in Dunham were reported to members.

Cllr. Ian Oakden gave a short report on his meeting with the Area Highway Manager from Notts CC (Highway) Mr Ian Parker.

It was reported that road signage improvements were to be planned for the High Marnham junction with the A57. Other issues raised by members were investigated but not agreed by the Area Manager .

It was recommended that cleaning of the reflective markers be considered. It was considered that the Payback Scheme be asked to undertake this task where it was safe to do so.

Some traffic white lines, within the Parish boundary were identified as requiring repainting. Notts CC (Highways) would arrange for this work to be completed in due course.

### **b. Footpaths and Parish Lanes.**
