Minutes of the ordinary meeting of Pentewan Valley Parish Council held in Pentewan Village Hall, 15 Glentowan Road Pentewan PL26 6DB started at 7pm on Wednesday 21 February 2024.

(23/207) Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllrs. Mike Ward, Miles Avery, and Toni Dowrick.

(23/208) Minutes of a Meeting of Pentewan Valley Parish Council It was RESOLVED that the minutes of the Parish Council held on 17 January 2024, be signed as an accurate record of the meeting.

(23/209) Declarations of Interest on Items on the Agenda

Cllr Strawford declared an interest in agenda item 14e, Pentewan Car Park. Cllrs Strawford had been granted a dispensation by the parish council to speak and vote on matters relating to the car park until May 2025.

(23/210) Chairman's Announcements

There were no announcements.

(23/211) Public Participation

Angela Taylor the Centre Manager from the Mevagissey Activity Centre gave an update on the financial position and the progress the MAC has made since the grant application was submitted in December 2023. Following questions from Councillors it was confirmed that the centre had introduced hire charges for clubs using the centre and monthly memberships.

(23/212) Grant Funding Application

It was **Resolved** that the Parish Council would award grant funding of £1000 to the Mevagissey Activity Centre (MAC)

(23/213) Cornwall Councillors Report

Cllr Mustoe's had organised a volunteer clean up on the parish boundary at Tregorrick, his report had been circulated. Cllr Bunney gave an update on The Trewhiddle pedestrian refuge meeting that he had attended, his report had been circulated.

(23/214) Crime and Disorder

There were no instances of crime or disorder to report.

(23/215) Planning and Related Matters.

PA24/00594. Rearrangement of existing parking spaces and proposed additional parking spaces, cycle shelter and electric car charging points.

St Austell Community Hospital Porthpean Road St Austell Cornwall. Angela Warwick from situ8 gave an update on the vehicle and parking arrangements proposed. It was **RESOLVED** that Pentewan Valley parish council agree in principle to this application with the provision that the bridleway be included in the drainage plans and that consideration is given to clear vision for vehicles exiting the site onto Porthpean Road.

(23/216) Climate, Ecology & Environment Advisory Committee.

Meeting note from the CEEAC meeting had been circulated, Cllr Muskett advised that the tree and hedge planting was a real success 25 volunteers attended on Saturday to plant the hedges and 30 volunteers attended on Sunday to plant the trees despite the wet weather. The event was covered on Radio Cornwall and in the local newspapers. Another enquiry had been made for more tree planting which was being looked into.

(23/217) Neighbourhood Development Plan

Minutes of NDP steering group meeting had been circulated. Cllr Street gave an update on the progress of the NDP, the Wildlife Resources Map from ERCCIS and the Design Codes meeting held on 22 January 2024.

(23/218) Community Levelling Up Programme

The clerk advised that an updated quote had been received from the lift supplier and Cllr Strawford confirmed the new quote was for a slightly different design of lift, but it was still suitable for the project.

There was a lack of volunteers available to organise the day, it was decided to wait and see what Plans other local parish councils had and support them.

Cllr Mustoe gave an update, Cllr Strawford advised that the contractors had been leaving the gate to the boat yard open.
