Will you please express Chideock Parish Council's surprise (and disbelief) at this announcement by the Political Group Leaders within Dorset Council. Apart from other considerations, this decision surely goes against Central Government guidelines for returning to In person Meetings and appears to be illegal with reference to the outcome of Hertfordshire County Council & Ors v Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government [2021] EWHC 1093 (Admin) (28 April 2021). A Judgement which confirmed that once the Coronavirus Act powers had lapsed, council meetings would have to be held in person. New primary legislation would be required to allow councils to meet and make decisions using virtual technology.	
						Chideock Parish Council questions the waste of Dorset Council money (when Dorset Council has already announced a significant budget deficit for 2021-2022) on hybrid technology without any proof of the loss of participation from residents. Surely residents were prepared to attend public meetings pre-lockdowns so why not return to that practice now. In addition it is likely that many residents simply don't have the equipment or the connectivity to join virtually anyway. CPC also question the statement that there would be: "further dispensation for all councillors to ensure that members who cannot attend a meeting in person over the coming months do not lose their seat on Dorset Council." Would you not agree that if a councillor cannot attend meetings over a period of months then surely they should lose their seat on Dorset Council as they would appear to not be functioning correctly. What is the point in participating in a meeting virtually if you CANNOT vote on the subject?? In summary, the Parish Council has many concerns about this decision by the Political Group Leaders and ask that you pass these concerns on to Dorset Council."
