THE BERWICK ST JAMES 50 CLUB, FOR RAISING MONEY FOR THE CHURCH ROOF

1) The concept

50 people pay in £10/month for a year commencing 1st January 2011. They take a '£10 share', which is recognised as a 'number' which is entered into a draw at the end of each month. This draw gives as the prize half the money taken that month. If it is assumed all 50 numbers have been sold this means £250 would be the prize, and £250 would be retained for the church roof fund. At the end of the year £3,000 would have been raised towards the church roof, and £3,000 distributed in prize money.

2) Membership rules

- 2.1. Numbers to be entered in to the monthly prize draw will be issued on a first come first served basis, and will only be available from the promoter of the lottery. (Contact: Ian Fisher, tel. number 01722 790214)
- 2.2. A 'number' costs £10/month, which can be purchased by cheque or cash for a number of months, or by a cheque for £120 covering the whole year. Cheques should be made payable to the 'Berwick St James PCC (Roof Fund)'.
- 2.3. Each number purchased will be entered into the monthly draw.
- 2.4. To qualify for a monthly draw the member must have paid their fee covering the respective monthly draw to be able to participate.
- 2.5. If there are any unsold numbers available individuals can join at any time during the year, and, having paid the appropriate fee, their numbers will be entered into the next monthly draw.
- 2.6. The 50 Club monthly draw will only take place if there are 30 or more numbers taken up for that month.
- 2.7. There are no restrictions in the quantity of remaining numbers purchased by applicants, but applicants must be over 16 years of age to participate.
- 2.8. The draws will normally take place on a monthly basis at The Boot on the last Friday of each month, at 9 p.m.. Where it is not possible to undertake a draw within the specific month the draw will be carried forward and drawn along with the following month(s) draws.
- 2.9. The winners will be advised by telephone or e-mail (as applicable) as soon as practicable after the draw has taken place.
- 2.10. The results will be published in the Parish Magazine and on the Village web site.
- 2.11. All prize money paid out will be by cheque.
- 2.12. Of the total monthly income collected half will go to the Church Roof Fund, and the other half will be the prize for the month.
- 2.13. In a dispute, the decision of the promoter is final.
