Minutes of meeting held at Plaitford Village Hall on 21st November 2016

61/16 Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillor G Bailey (TVBC).

62/16 *The minutes of the 19th September 2016 meeting were agreed and signed.*

63/16 Interests

No interests were declared.

64/16 Matters Arising

Cllr K Curtis produced some examples of possible banner designs for the Parish Council website. After much discussion is it was agreed that as it is a rural parish the banner should be a view of animals in the open countryside. All members agreed to submit possible photographs to the Clerk for the next meeting. Cllr K Curtis emphasised that if a single photograph was to be used it needed to be capable of being cropped into a long narrow strip.

65/16 Clerk's Report

A Post Box has been purchased but it is awaiting the labels.

66/16 Consultations

After considerable discussion it was agreed that this Parish council would not submit any comments on the NFNPA's Local Plan Review.

67/16 Parish Lengthsman Scheme

It was agreed that this should be deferred until January when more information would be available.

68/16 Finance

- a) It was proposed by Cllr K Curtis and seconded by Cllr Porter that the Parish Council would donate £250 towards the cost of the new shed at the Village Hall: this was resolved.
- b) The draft Budget for 2017-18 was considered. The combination of s.137 spending and grants to the Village Hall has taken £250 from the contingency in 2016-17; in addition there is now a standing charge for the bank account of £72 per year. It was proposed by Cllr Stacey and seconded by Cllr K Curtis that the precept should be raised to £3200 for 2017-18: this was resolved.
- c) Direct debit to HMRC (PAYE) of £128.20 was noted.
- d) Cheque number 269 for £255.16 to J Wright (salary) was approved and signed.

69/16 Planning Applications

Gardeners Farm, Flowers Lane - Change of use of agricultural barn to a dwelling house - "Support"
