I have had an increasing number of senior young people attending youth club, which is great but as I explained with capacity, I can only run one night a week. However, I am concerned about the increasing number of ASB issues presenting in Lyneham and what this may develop into without further support.

- 4. How much are the council willing to contribute from Parish Funds, and if this does meet the required amount for the provider.
- 5. Are they content with identifying other funding streams (Area Board, Solar Farm Fund)
- 6. How would the Parish Council like the provider to advertise, evaluate and provide information regarding sessions to the Parish Council.
