# Village Hall

New curtains/blinds – agreed Mrs Blackburn and Mrs Paris to look into this and also the cost of cleaning the existing curtains and renewing the lining

Hall fees – next agenda

New socket – agreed to have a new double socket installed under the projector screen – up to £250

Wall – we have one price and are awaiting others

Logo – agreed 5 for to have one

Round logo – 4 for 1 abstention

This is being produced at no cost to the PC

Also agreed unanimously for Mr Bevans to obtain a Wesh and a Scottish flag to be flown on their saints days

#### Replacement notice board for the bus shelter

The PCllrs went outside and decided the best place for the new notice board was at the side of the porch facing the road – agreed unanimously

It was agreed to go with the grey board and not take the bus shelter boards down until the new one is up

#### Roads and hedges

Agreed for the clerk to arrange a meeting at the cross roads with NCC in about 3 weeks. Clerk to speak to the owner of the hedge

A member of the public questioned the legality of the building work at The Dials Grey Lane, they outlined what they wanted to know – agreed to discuss more under planning as it was an agenda item

#### Correspondence

A letter from a member of the public has been received concerning the new Gateway signs – it was agreed the clerk should reply to them answering their questions

One concern in the letter was the close proximity of the new sign to the old one on School Lane - agreed to look into removing the old sign

Change of use and conversion of an existing outbuilding to a new dwelling annexe with games room ancillary to the main dwelling

The Dials Grey Lane – following on from the open meeting a letter was read out from the owner, stating that he had gone to NSDC planners and cleared all the work with them. The PC where happy with this, though the neighbour would like the PC to check for themselves

Pepperbox Cottage School Lane – a question had been raised concerning the entrance to the driveway and the roadside wall, it was asked if this was too near to the road Cllr Rainbow agreed to look into both questions for us and report back
