Cleansing Operatives/Playground Inspectors	Operatives completing the inspection or cleaning of Playgrounds, MUGA's and Outdoor Gyms shall be issued with P.P.E. such as but not limited to gloves, nitrile gloves, face masks and goggles				
	 Operatives reminded that existing PPE required for a task should be used as normal and if reusable cleaned/disinfected after use. 				

Signs and Posters (General public) Additional precautions

- Operatives reminded to always ensure that they have sufficient PPE for the day's work before leaving the depot.
- Operatives reminded through posters and briefings to wash hands or use anti-bacterial hand gel frequently.
- Operatives reminded through posters and assessments to not touch eyes, nose or mouth if they are wearing gloves of if hands are not clean.
- Operatives reminded through posters and assessments to cough or sneeze into tissues and to dispose of the used tissue correctly.
- Signs and Posters will be displayed within Playgrounds, MUGA's, skate parks and outdoor gyms advising visitors of precautions to follow to prevent the spread of infection.

Currently signs will display government guidance such as

- Promotion of good Hygiene controls such as increased use of hand sanitizer gel especially after touching surfaces.
- The need to wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds before leaving home and again when returning home.
- The banning of Food and drink within playgrounds, and other play areas.
- Safe disposal of tissues/disposable gloves and disposable masks.
- Promotion of taking home waste should a litter bin be full or unavailable.
- Need to adhere to social distancing measures and to keep a 2m distance if possible in line with government guidance.
- Advising on the Limiting of the numbers within enclosed areas and on equipment
- Request that only 1 family member accompanies a child in playgrounds.
- Promotion of consideration to others and the maximum at peak periods.
- Requesting that users don't congregate within the boundary fence.
