It would appear that the maximum level of council tax increase is being considered at 4.99 %. Councillor Harris updated the council regarding the 59/60 bus. The subsidy was protected last year and it has been included in the budget for this year. Uno Bus no longer wish to operate buses in Northamptonshire so a new operator is needed by March 2024. Councillor Harris is having a meeting on Friday to discuss the service the 59/60route is not a commercial route so the aim is to maintain the service or find a suitable alternative. The Bull Asset of Community Value application is being considered on 12 th December 2023.
