The PC felt concern about this and asked the clerk to write again to confirm. • Footpath at the back of Pinfold Lane- This has been reported, and it was noted that it has been sprayed and cleared. • SLOW marking on Staythorpe Rd Averham- This was reported. VIA replied that the marking was redundant due to the 20mph school sign at the location. The PC requested the clerk ask to have the road marking reinstated due to the proximity of the primary school. • Speeding in Averham- Cllr. Bradey reported that the speed watch equipment is still unavailable. The Clerk is to pursue LIS funding for an interactive speed sign. • Bench/notice board in Staythorpe – Cllr Williams will refurbish these when the weather improves. • Moving Defibrillator/signage -Cllr Allan reported that there were residents willing to host the defibrillator on the corner of Church Lane and Staythorpe Rd. He and Mr Wolfenden will source an electrician. The PC voted unanimously to move the defibrillator.
