#### **POLICE WATCH**

Police have made us aware of a number of things to look out for in the area, although crime figures continue to be very low.

- THEFTS FROM VEHICLES: Early December saw a spate of thefts from cars in the Ollerton and Broughton areas. Parked cars are tempting targets, particularly in the run up to Christmas. Don't leave anything on show when you leave your car, even for a few minutes, as that's all it takes to smash and grab!
- PRESENT WARNING: Notts police would like to remind parents that quad bikes, off-road bikes and mini motorcycles are not suitable gifts for most children as there are very few places in this area that they can be ridden legally. They can only be ridden on private land, not on footpaths or the roads or any area the public has access to, and even pushing a bike along a footpath or road without tax can lead to it being confiscated.
- KEEP 'EM PEELED Everyone can keep abreast of crime figures in their area by accessing the www.police.uk website and typing in their postcode.
- NO MORE CASH FOR SCRAP The new laws on selling scrap metal, designed to make it a less tempting target for thieves, came into force on December 3rd 2012. These laws make it illegal to receive cash payments for scrap metal, and make sellers give identification.
- THEFT OF ST MARY'S BENCH We are happy to report to those of you who read the alert that the bench outside St Mary's Church had been stolen that in fact it had been removed for refurbishment by the donors.
