

Licensing Rules Issue 5.0 November 2022

- 1. All members may personally introduce friends as their guests but no person who is eligible for membership shall be introduced more than once in any calendar week and no member may introduce more than two friends at any one time.
 - Members shall be responsible for the good behaviour of guests introduced by them.
- 2. The Club may also admit
 - (a) Any member/ supporter/ official of any visiting sporting team at a bona fide fixture.
 - (b) Any person belonging or elected to an organisation attending a bona fide meeting at the Club's registered premises.
 - (c) Any relative of a member who is on holiday/visiting/temporarily staying with a member or a member's family for a period not exceeding 21 days and nights.
 - (d) Persons attending special functions in the Clubs registered premises each function taking place with the Committee's prior approval and are directly connected to a member or member's family.
 - Intoxicating liquor may be sold to such persons by or on behalf of the Club.
- 3. On up to 12 special occasions during the twelve month period in addition to above, the Club may sell intoxicating liquor for such special occasions as:-
 - (a) Open days, whereby the Club is open to the local community.
 - (b) Parties and any other special function not covered above.
- 4. Intoxicating liquor may only be sold for consumption on the Club site.
- 5. There is a period of 48 hours between a member being accepted for membership and admitted to the privileges of the Club.
- 6. Club License hours are 10:00 am to 22:30 pm on any day in the year.
- 7. The upholding of these rules is the responsibility of the Bar Committee.
- 8. The seating capacity of the Club interior is 52. An additional 8 people may stand giving a maximum internal safe capacity of 60 people. A further 11 people can sit on the verandah and any number may stand.
