As you no doubt are aware we have carried out a number of improvements and replacement of equipment as required for the Village Hall, and play park area, thus far in 2021. These include replacement plants in front of the hall, a replacement back door leading to the yard area at the west of the building, this area has also been completely refurbished, will all weeds and overgrown ivy removed, and the ground area has had a membrane installed covered by loose shale which hopefully should keep it neat and tidy for years to come.

At our recent AGM we looked at the financial situation and comparing income over expenditure for 2019 against 20220 the difference showed a £4,000 shortfall. We are sure that both our committees will continue to work closely together, for the benefit of all members of the village and surrounding areas.
