1. **Apologies:** There were no apologies.
2. **Open Forum:** No members of the public attended.
3. **Declarations of Interest:** There were no declarations of interest.
4. **Minutes of Previous Meeting:** The minutes were accepted and signed as a true record.
5. **Matters Arising:**
 - a). New bench - arrangements to be made to install.
 - b). Norton Trust - Cllr. Mrs. Owen was proposed as the P.C. representative on the Trust. She accepted. Clerk to Notify the trust of this matter.
6. **Financial Matters:**

Cheques raised for the following Clerks salary £263.67 Nov/Dec 2019, S.V. Jeavons - Microsoft Yearly subscription - £79.99, SALC £27.00 for training.

Precept - Clerk gave a report on finances to date. After some discussion it was unanimously agreed to keep the Precept the same as last year, £4,725.00.
7. **Correspondence.** a) Shrop. Voice and Field Work mags from CPRE.
Passed to Cllr. Breakwell.
8. **Planning Applications:** Still no update on Cattery in Green Lane and Reynolds Joinery at Wootton - despite numerous emails requesting an up-date.
9. **Affordable Housing Grant** - update there was nothing to report.
10. **A49 Trunk Road.** North side of railway crossing - flooding. H.E. in 2016 commissioned a report that the P.C. understands

found that the rainwater drains were broken from the railway to the boundary of Onibury further south. This results in flooding outside Wootton Farm and also creates the need to close the A49 Trunk Road. There seems no run off for the rainwater since the crossing was updated and has made the situation worse. The flooding near the bus stop North of the crossing means vehicles travel on wrong side of carriageway causing a Health and Safety issue. It also floods outside Park Farm further north.

11. Parish Matters: Flooding - Norton Lane, outside Station House and other areas of village. A gully in Norton Lane gets blocked and causes water to flow down Lane ending up flooding entrance to village outside Station House'. Road sweeper needed in village and at Whitty Tree. It was suggested that individual Councillors contact the different agencies when they see or have a problem rather than wait to next meeting. Clerk to supply some contacts.

Web Site: - Chair reported on course attended dealing with all aspects of new regulations. It seems that it may be that the Parish Council have to consider shutting down The Parish Web Site. To be monitored and discussed at a future meeting.

Chair mentioned V.E. Day in May -, did the P.C. wish to celebrate in anyway. Discuss at next meeting.
