FOI Request to Southern Water. Details of discharges from the SW Staplehurst Treatment Works into the River Beult during 2022 were due to be available at the end of March, 2023 but have not been seen. The Parish Clerk is asked to send a reminder to SW.

5. Housing Needs Survey. No further information to date regarding Tess O'Sullivan' agreement to carry out the HNS. It is suggested that the covering letter with the HNS should stress to everyone the need to complete the survey, irrespective of whether they or members of their family have a housing need. Whilst it is important that the questions for this survey are the same as those in the 2016 survey so that the results are a direct comparison, it is suggested that there should be an addendum to the survey asking the following:Have you been affected by surface water or foul water drainage problems?
Have you been affected by problems due to low pressure and/or failure of the water supply?
Have you been affected by issues relating to planning?
Have you been affected by the loss of bus service 5 on weekday evenings or all day on Sundays?

There remain 4 places to be filled on the Parish Council.
