<b>2.</b>	<p><b>Presentation by Mark &amp; Kuan Over</b></p> <p>(APM - 381) DI formally welcomed Mark &amp; Kuan Over, the new owners of 51 Degrees North, (old Frascati site). Kuan Over gave a brief overview of her background in catering and of their current business: Chapters Cafe. Mark &amp; Kuan Over outlined their plans for 51 Degrees North and took questions from the meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plans comprise of a Phase 1: Cafe, both eat in and takeaway, and a mini shop, and moving onto Phase 2: Bed &amp; Breakfast.</li> <li>Work has started with repairs to the existing roof and internal renovations will start early June.</li> <li>Parking area outside is owned by SCC Highways. Parking is Free.</li> <li>Plans were agreed last year.</li> <li>Kuan will be mainly on site and any problems during the renovations should be direct to Mark or Kuan.</li> <li>Initial opening times will be Sunday to Saturday 830-5pm depending on footfall.</li> </ul> <p>DI thanked Mark and Kuan Over for taking time to come and talk to the meeting and wished them every success with the opening.</p>
