8. Broseley place plan.

There has been a lot of correspondence and articles in the press about the Broseley Place Plan and the CIL funds within. Clerk forwarded all the relevant information at the time of the first press report.

Clerk has forwarded a copy of the current place plan. Which includes Barrow Parish.

Clerk has recently attended a Parish Forum meeting where Parish Plans were discussed. There should be an opportunity to update Barrow's part of the plan soon.

CIL was also discussed with a presentation on how funds will be spent.

In summary development incurs several levy's one of which is Community infrastructure levy.

Part is paid to the parish, part is held by Shropshire Council for spending in the local place plan area and the remainder is held by Shropshire Council for larger projects. So the CIL held for spending in place plan area could be spent in Broseley Parish or Barrow Parish. Clerk will bring the amount in the various pots to the meeting.

A Parish has 5 years to spend its part. It has to be on infrastructure.
