PLN23/013 **Planning Applications** PLN23/013.1 To consider the following new planning applications: 23/02229/AGRIC2 Church Farm, Aldworth Road, Compton - Application to determine if prior approval is required for a proposed: New agricultural storage building Resolved: To object to the application with the following reasons: Proximity to nearby properties: The Council believes that the proposed development is out of proportion for its proximity to the dwellings in the surrounding area. Obstruction of the view of the AONB: The development is also criticized for obstructing the view of the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). The National Planning Policy Framework states: 176. Great weight should be given to conserving and enhancing landscape and scenic beauty in National Parks, the Broads and Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty which have the highest status of protection in relation to these issues. This development fails to conserve or enhance the AONB. Increase in vehicular access along the track adjacent to the dwellings near the church: Concerns were raised regarding the potential increase in vehicular access along the track adjacent to the dwellings near the church.
