National and County Competition News

Bowls England. The national competition draws are due to be published on Thursday 1st April and will be found on their website <u>www.bowlsengland.com</u> The national finals will run from Thursday 25th August to Sunday 11th September.

If you've entered a competition, please check the format as in some instances, this differs from the county format below. See the Competitions Portal section of the website for all the details.

Bowls Leicestershire. The county championship and competition draws are on the website <u>www.bowlsleicestershire.com</u> Please be aware that the format (bowls per player and number of ends per match) of certain competitions has changed again so please check before you play your first game. The formats for Championship matches (Leamington qualifiers) are as follows: Singles (2 bowls/21 ends or 4 bowls/21 shots); Pairs (4 bowls per player/18 ends); Triples (3 bowls per player/18 ends); Fours (2 bowls per player/18 ends).

As with last year the number of qualifiers for each championship event at Leamington has been reduced to 48. The 13 counties with the most entries will have two qualifiers.

League News

Loughborough Triples League: Our two teams are in Division 1 and matches start on Monday 25th April with reigning champions Sands away at Belgrave and Lighthouse at home to Fosseway.

Leicester League: We are in Division 1 with the first match on Wednesday 4th May away at Countesthorpe. The first round of the cup is at home to Narborough on Wednesday 25th May.

Ladies Friday Triples League: We have two teams entered with the first matches scheduled to take place on Friday 24th June.
