SHOTTENDANE ROAD, MARGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Shottendane Road, Margate.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 4 November 2019, with estimated completion by 23 January 2020. The road will be re-opened over the Christmas period.

Shottendane Road will be closed in sections between the junction with High Street (Garlinge) working eastwards to the junction with Manston Road, to the extent indicated at any time by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Shottendane Road, B2050 Manston Road and Manston Road.

Local access to the remainder of Shottendane Road continues from either direction up to where the road is closed at any time.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
