Jubilee Tree planned for Staythorpe – the following has been received from RWE –

As discussed earlier I can confirm that RWE give permission for the Parish Council to plant a tree with a suitable small plaque to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, on the landscaped area of our land at the site entrance which is accessible to the public walking past the site.

You have confirmed that the planting will be of a tree sapling, the ground will be hand dug and that the planting will not take place until October or November this year, as this is the best time of year for tree planting. The tree must not become a hazard to pedestrians and road users as it grows.

Please could you mark out where you would like the tree to be planted in this area? Could you also confirm

- the type of tree that is to be planted
- the ground depth requirements for the planting of the tree
- who will be responsible for maintaining the tree, the Parish and/or RWE, for example watering in first year and pruning in the future
- the wording on the plaque and its design will be provided to us for our approval before the planting takes place
- you agree for photographs to be taken of the planting for our internal news communications

To support this event further we would like to offer to make a contribution to the cost of the tree and the commemorative plaque, please let me know if you would like to take up this offer and provide details of approximate costs.

It was proposed an Oak Tree was planted at this location. Cllr Morrel to plant the tree in Kelham, Cllr Allan to plant the Holly tree requested in Averham church. Cllrs Allan and Morrel will discuss and look at the Staythorpe location.
