- 6) Overflowing manhole by 29 Oxendon Road. Following discussion with Steve Whelton at DDC this is to be flushed when the drains are cleaned. Clerk to report. 768777 Outside NCC control clerk to check whose responsibility.
- 7) Passing place on Desborough Road between the 2nd and 3rd cattle grid on the left hand side going away from Arthingworth a very deep pothole requires maintenance. It is very dangerous, especially when full of water. 768771 15/3 referred to David Coleman
- 8) Potholes Braybrooke Road before the boundary road and the last cattle grid. 768765 15/3 referred to David Coleman
- 9) Tree outside 1 Kelmarsh Road (requires pollarding) DDC will shortly issue an update
