

NWPC RIGHTS OF WAY AND LENGTHSMAN – SEP 20

Footpath NW FP 20: Bent Street/Five Bells Lane. The owner of the land adjacent to the northern (Bent Street) end of this path has cut back the side ingress. At the time of writing, no work has so far been carried out by the owner of the southern (Five Bells Lane).

New Right of Way: Church Lane – Heathman Street. HCC is proceeding with the final Public Notice of intent designating this path as a Footpath Right of Way. This ends on 18 Sep 20, after which it will be formally adopted, and we can pursue the issue of resurfacing.

Footpath School Lane – A343. Comment was raised with regard to the accessibility of a stile on the path running between School Lane and the A343. The location is on the Over Wallop section of the path. The footpath officer has forwarded this to the OWPC Parish Clerk but at time of writing no acknowledgment or response has been received.

Footpath Officer Work:

3.5 hours of work on the paths during August.
