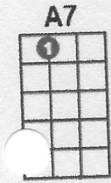
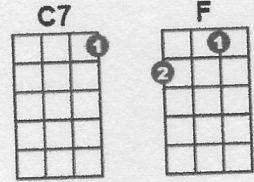
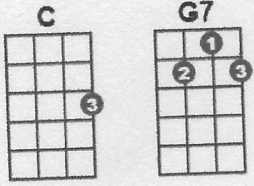


Don't Fence Me In
