The minutes of the last meeting were agreed and it was reported that very good feedback had been received about the Quiz Night with preliminary figure of funds raised @ £1,033.

Matters arising

Electrical work has started in line with insurance requirements, but it appears all the work needing to be completed was not included in the original quote that was selected (two quotes were received and the one accepted).

Tank paint has been used to sort out dry rot problems. The steps were removed, repaired and replaced. A camera was used to determine any further rot or retained water.

The blocked drain has been attended to.

The damaged window blinds cannot be repaired so it was agreed to consider their replacement at a later date.

The new Chairman has been accepted by the Charity Commission and arrangements confirmed with the bank as a new signatory.

It was suggested that a DVH website be set up, this idea was supported but members prefer to continue to hall bookings by phone call only.
